For their philosophic goal was the understanding of the spirit of Man and his relationship to the universe. And they could only speculate upon it. They never *proved* their contention that Man was a spirit clothed in flesh, they could only assert it.

And so they drowned in the avalanche of superstition which engulfed the world in the Dark Ages.

Why did they fail? They needed the higher mathematics and electronics which would, over two thousand years later, develop their philosophies.

These *were* developed. But they were used for different purposes than those intended, and Man turned his back upon their lofty dreams while building planes to bomb cities and atom bombs to wipe out the Mankind no one had ever understood.

Until Scientology.\*

And in it the goals of Greek Philosophy live again.

Using modern developments in the sciences, it became possible to approach again the basic problems: What is Man? What is his relationship to the Universe? What is the Universe?

Scientology, after a third of a century of careful research and investigation can answer, with scientific truth those questions and prove the answers.

This is rather startling.

We have come so far from Thales, Heraclitus, Parmenides and Democritus that we have almost forgotten what they were trying to discover. But if you consult writings of the work they did over two thousand years ago you will see what it was.

## Scientology Answers

Materialistic sciences have sought to invalidate the entire field by shrugging the problem off with the equally impossible answers that one is merely meat and all life arose by spontaneous and accidental combustion from a sea of ammonia. Such "answers" sound more like pre-Buddhist India where the world was said to be carried on seven pillars that stood on seven pillars which stood on a turtle and, in exasperation to the child's question as to what the turtle stood on, "Mud! And it's mud from there on down!"

It is the nature of Truth that if one knows it, even more things get understood. The disease and decay of Asia tends to invalidate their concepts as Truth and in the West, war, where soldiers saw "Gott Mit Uns" on the slain enemy belt buckles tended to end the domination of the churches of those times — for God could not be on both sides of such Devil's work, or so the soldiers reasoned.

SCIENTOLOGY: an applied religious philosophy; the study of knowledge in its fullest sense; a highly workable technology for changing conditions; the fastest growing movement in the world.  
L. RON HUBBARD: the Founder of Scientology. See biography below.  
PROCESSING: exact techniques developed by L. Ron Hubbard through the application of modern scientific research procedure to solve the problems posed by life and the physical universe; the application of Scientology techniques and procedures to the individual to bring about increased awareness, ability and effectiveness.  
CLEAR: an extremely **high** state of existence attainable through Scientology processing and training.  
PRECLEAR: one receiving processing; one who is not yet Clear.  
RELEASE: the state of being released from the factors in the mind which inhibit or enforce the individual. There are seven levels of Release to pass through on the route to Clear. The state of Release is readily attainable through processing.  
AUDITOR: one who listens; one who has been trained to apply processing with precision to bring about the state of Release in

others; one who has successfully completed one or more of eight levels of training and has been awarded a valid Scientology certificate for the levels completed.  
BOOK AUDITOR: one who has read Scientology books and has successfully applied the techniques taught therein. To obtain a Hubbard Book Auditor certificate, write to the Director of Certifications and Awards of your nearest Scientology Organization.  
SCIENTOLOGIST: one who knows that Scientology works. There are millions of Scientologists in the world.  
SCIENTOLOGY FOUNDATION: the evening and weekend public service organization of Scientology.  
MISSION: a group of trained Scientologists that offers Scientology services to the public. One or more of the group have been licensed to practice Scientology professionally.  
FIELD STAFF MEMBER: a Scientologist who is well informed about the services of Scientology, sells books and selects people to the Central Organization for training, processing and membership. To become a Field Staff Member apply to the Director of Clearing of your nearest Central Organization.

SOCRATES, ARISTOTLE, EUCLID, THALES, ETC.: Greek philosophers of the 7th, 6th and 5th Centuries B.C. whose works and ideas laid the foundations for Western thought and science.  
DIANETICS: that branch of Scientology that covers mental anatomy. From the Greek DIA, through, and NOUS, soul. DIANETICS is further redefined as WHAT THE SOUL IS DOING TO THE BODY.  
PRE-BUDDHIST: coming before the influence of Buddha.  
"GOTT MIT UNS": German. 'God Is With Us'.  
INVARIABLE: a constant; not changing.  
SAVANTS: men of deep or extensive learning.  
SAGES: profoundly wise men.  
CORVETTE: a small, lightly-armed vessel used mostly for convoy escort.  
ENTURBULATE: cause to be turbulent or agitated and disturbed.

## Scientology Answers

Even Christ's great commandment of "Love thy neighbour" seems to have less force today in a world of income tax, inflation and the slaughter of civil populations in the name of peace.

So without in any way condemning or scorning any man's beliefs, Scientology arose from the ashes of a spiritless science and again asked — and answered — the eternal questions.

That the answers have the force of truth is attested by the results. Instead of the sickness of religious India, Scientologists are seldom ill. Instead of internal warfare such as the riots of Alexandria, Scientologists live in relative harmony with each other and have skills that restore relations rapidly.

The world tends to attack new things and Scientology has had its share from vested interest groups and governments but it keeps rising eventually victorious from each clash without bitterness.

Various interesting results proceed from the practice of Scientology. One's intelligence increases and one's ability to handle his problems is markedly bettered.

One does not have to study Scientology very long to know that one does not have to die to find out what he is or where he is going after death, for *one can experience* it all for himself with no persuasion or hypnotism or "faith."

So Scientology is different mainly because one doesn't have to *believe* in it to have it work. Its truths are of the order of "Is this black?" "Is this white?" You can see for yourself something is black if it's black and that something is white when it's white.

No tricks of logic are needed to prove any point and Scientologists only ask people to look for themselves.

Thus, along with science, Scientology can achieve positive invariable results. Given the same conditions, one always gets the same results. And anyone given the same conditions can obtain the same results.

What has happened is the *superstition* has been subtracted from spiritual studies. And today this is a very acceptable state of affairs to Man.

The ultimate freedom depends on knowing the ultimate Truth. Truth is not what people *say* it is, it is what it is. And Truth, quite remarkably, sets one free, just like philosophers have said down the ages.

What the philosophers did *not* say was how free can one get? And that is the surprise contained in Scientology for everyone who walks the Road to Truth — one *can* be totally free.

Naturally this makes no friendly news to the person who wants slaves and Fascistic, Capitalistic and even some more liberal creeds forbid that utterly, for who could be a master, so they think, where no slave wears his chains? They miss the point entirely, for who *has* to be a master?

When you yourself hold the Truth the shadows by which you are bound tend to slither away.

And when you at last know for yourself in your own experience that Scientology does have the answers, and when you have applied them, you have the result all philosophers, savants, sages and saviours have always dreamed of — and freedom as well.

As much of Scientology is true for you as you know of it, those who know it only by name react to the hope of it. And as one advances upon the road, one knows more and more of it and is more and more free. Unlike so many promises made to man and which have made him fear disappointment, Scientology delivers. It may be over a rough road. It may be over a smooth one. But Scientology eventually delivers all it says it can.

## L. Ron Hubbard

Scientology was developed by L. Ron Hubbard, an American writer and philosopher.

It was completed after 35 years of research.

Hubbard was born in Tilden, Nebraska, March 13, 1911.

Much of Hubbard's early youth was spent in the American West and he travelled extensively in Asia as a young man.

He studied Science and Mathematics at George Washington University, graduating from Columbian College. He attended Princeton University and obtained a degree as Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) from Sequoia University.

Before World War II he was well known in explorational circles and is to this day a member of the Explorer's Club.

He wrote and published over 15,000,000 words of articles and novels of all kinds before World War II.

During that war he served as a commander of corvettes and was extensively decorated.

Crippled and blind at the end of the war, he resumed his studies of philosophy and by his discoveries recovered so fully that he was re-classified in 1949 for full combat duty. It is a matter of medical record that he has twice been pronounced dead and that in 1950 he was given a perfect score on mental and physical fitness reports.

Revolted by war and Man's inhumanity to Man, he resigned his commission rather than assist government research projects.

He published his original thesis on his work and the startling popularity of a thesis brought publishers to offer him a contract for a popular work on the subject which in 1950 soared to the top of the best-seller lists and stayed there.

And L. Ron Hubbard's fiction works are more popular than ever, including his latest best-seller *Battlefield Earth*.

Unlike any other philosopher in any age, Hubbard has led a very full and adventurous life. He has been the hero in numerous novels and even of a famous motion picture.

Probably no philosopher of modern times has had the popularity and appeal of Hubbard or such startling successes within his own lifetime. And Mankind has had no better friend.

# What Scientology Can Do For You

All that Scientology has to offer is understanding. What a simple statement that is and yet that one word, understanding, is the key to all of man's problems and opens the door to a future without fear, without sickness, without insanity, without death, for beyond that door is the road of truth, of beauty, of creation, of hope unlimited where a man can create a universe of his own.

To understand is defined in the dictionary as "Comprehend, to perceive the significance or explanation or cause or nature of, know how to deal with." Well, throughout recorded history and probably long before that, man has been attempting to understand things: why it rains, why the world turns, why the sun rises and sets, why things grow and why things die, but particularly he has tried to understand himself and the human mind.

It follows then, that if man has consistently tried to understand himself and his mind, there must be something to understand and that something must be very worthwhile indeed. If it was not it is hardly conceivable that after all these thousands of years man would still be seeking to understand. And the only road to understanding is truth.

This is the road that Scientology follows and by following that road, by refusing to deviate from that road no matter what, no matter what precious "traditions" had to be discarded, no matter what opposition he encountered, L. Ron Hubbard has broken through the seemingly insurmountable barriers that have frustrated man's attempts to understand the human mind. And it is this truth, this understanding of life, that Scientology offers you through its technology of processing and training.

With Scientology the sick can be made well, the insane sane and the able more able than was dreamed possible by even the most optimistic of savants. Documented proof of this we have by the carload, but the proof that really matters is the proof you provide yourself by trying Scientology. We have nothing to hide. You are not asked to join a secret fraternity, for secrecy, mystery, is the enemy of truth. The knowledge of Scientology is available to all who reach for it. It is as simple as that.

Like most things in life, understanding is a gradient. One must first understand the operation of the controls before one can drive a car. Similarly, one must know the data of a subject before one can understand that subject. Understanding how to drive a car one can then go on to understand the much larger concept of traffic control and road planning. So it is with Scientology.

Through Scientology processing (the application of Scientology technology in order to remove unwanted, unnecessary conditions in your life) and training you follow clear, concise and easy steps to full understanding of Scientology data, yourself, others and life. This combination of processing and training first of all remedies your problems in life in order that you may advance towards higher states of existence and understanding.

The fact that processing can make the insane sane and cure psychosomatic ills does not mean that Scientology is in the healing business. A science of the mind that cannot do these things is a very poor science indeed. It is a documented fact that when the first Scientology book appeared thirty-three years ago: "Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health," and became a runaway best-seller overnight, that sick people became well through just reading the book, that bed-ridden patients got up and walked out of hospitals after reading this book. Such is the power of truth, of understanding. But the

primary aim of Scientology is to make the able more able, for only through so doing can we hope to turn back the tide of insanity and self-destruction which is sweeping the world today. That, too, is the aim of Scientology.

That we know how to do this and are doing it, every day, and are succeeding with each revolution of the earth cannot be overemphasized. We do not, for instance, say "You are a psycho-nutticas which is incurable" or "Well, *maybe* we can help you." We know we can help you, we know what Scientology can do.

For instance, processing, like training, is done in stages or Grades. We call these the Grades of Release, in that at each grade you are released, in the true meaning of the word, from conditions in your own life and environment that prevent you from being more able than you are. For instance, the first four Grades of Release attained in processing accomplish the following. There is no maybe or perhaps about it.

Grade 0 — Improve your ability to communicate.

We instinctively revere the great artist, painter or musician, and society as a whole looks upon them as not quite ordinary beings. And they are not. They are a cut above Man. They were born this way and he who can communicate to others is a higher being who builds new worlds. A Grade 0 Release achieves this ability to communicate.

Grade I — Enable you to handle problems.

The being who can recognize the actual source of problems and so see them vanish is too rare to be easily comprehended. Man "solves" problems. A being in a higher state looks at them and they vanish. There are fantastic phenomena here which Man has never, before Scientology, examined. When a being can do this — make problems vanish with a glance — he certainly is no longer Man. A Grade I Release is able to do this.

Grade II — Give you relief from the hostilities and sufferings of life.

Man has never known, except in some of the rare miracle workers he regarded as saints, how to bring relief to various ills. The secret was that one is connecting oneself to what he abhors. To be able to easily bring relief to oneself and others from the hostilities and sufferings of life is a skill Man has seen only in healers. A Grade II Release has this ability.

Grade III — Give you freedom from the upsets of the past.

Man is chained to the upsets in his past. He has never known why he felt so upset and misunderstood about his family or people or situations. Most men dwell perpetually on troubles they have had. They lead sad lives. Freedom from the upsets of the past with the ability to face the future is almost an unknown condition to Man. It is attained as a Grade III Release.

Grade IV — Give you the ability to face the future and to change conditions.

Man's abilities tend to be individually specialized. He is so intent upon some action that he is clumsy in performing others. Moving out of a fixed condition and being able to do other things is attained as a Grade IV Release.

This, then, is just part of what Scientology can do for you. We will never betray your faith in us as long as you are one of us. We look forward to having you with us.

I am now able to look back and find where mistakes were made and how to avoid them in the future. Problems no longer seem to exist. 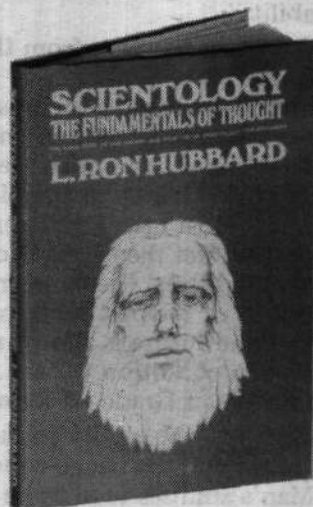
