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Introduction

This book offers an explanation to all the dynamics of life, allowing anyone the possibility to analyze the past but also predict any future outcome in any give situation and for any known person.

Life always follows the same alchemical rules, which are explained by symbols and structures within the logic of our own planet. When we understand them and how they apply in the manifestations of the reality we experience, we can actually gain a higher conscience of self and more responsibility over our actions. And this is the attitude that will then allow much more success, as well as the courage to deal with failure more peacefully.

The opposites of good and evil, past and future, heart and mind, good and bad, success and failure, are continually in interaction, despite our personal will and efforts, and it's for this reason that illusions trap us inside the deceptive idea that the material world and what we have represent things that remain permanent in time.

The only thing that is permanent is conscience, our love for spiritual awareness. Everything else transforms and tends to adapt according to our experiences and understanding, from good to better or worse, depending on our decisions.

A decision is never important by itself but in its relation to the outcome and the desire behind it, and that's what this book intends to show by using very ancient religious principles.

This is a book about magic, even though it explains how we can create and observe it with logic, will and love.

Numerology and Alchemy

Life on Earth, as the creation of our universe, follows specific rules, from which we learn, by repetition, and also by cyclic movements, repeatedly manifesting what we wish, often in a timeline of 5 years, even though we tend to neglect and forget our responsibility over the things that happen to us and around us.

Inside this system, the first manifestation occurs within, with the number one. One is the beginning, the conscience, the power of will, the need and the desire, all elements that either lead to construction or destruction.

When you are wishing for a construction, you are desiring the destruction of what you have, and when you wish for destruction, you're deliberately neglecting your power to build something.

The difference lays in how we use conscience, as the power of rejection leads to frustration but the will projected by a conscious desire leads to wonderful manifestations.

Whenever the energy of the mind is channeled, the heart activates its own power, which reinforces the mind. This is the reason why we are actually more powerful than what we imagine. Whatever the mind keeps registering, conceptualizing and forming in paradigms, is greatly empowered by the heart. And for this reason, we attract both what we want and don't want, or both, as when we get what we want and then lose it almost instantly.

Nonetheless, there is a chemical dynamic that is very important in the number two. The emotions that we project, reflect, like a lake, what we're doing. If we are angry, we attract angry people, if we are arrogant, we attract arrogant people, if we have fears, we attract fearful people and if we're afraid to love someone, we attract the same as well.

We may try to control the situations happening in front of us with words and attitudes. We can, indeed, apologize for what we do, or defeat our shadow, the other reflecting our inner self, using words or even fists. But the energy that is projected is never lesser or greater than its projection. Whatever you project, you get, and so, if you project your own death, you can get it too.

If we project a suffering that seems to never end, as what most people do, that is exactly what is obtained.

Many people think that the number two will always be a two. They believe that the outside is never reflecting the inside, and that this outside can be controlled. And the irony about this assumption is that, the action of trying to control the outside, forces the inside to change. You can only solve a problem by understanding what makes it a problem, and once you do, you can fix it because you, yourself, are fixed. You can't learn without changing the perspective of what you already know.

Meanings behind Alchemy

If I ask a woman what makes her angry and she tells me, then the answer is as important as the question, because I can only ask that which I want to know, and, if I want to know it, is because I'm willing to accept the solution, which means wanting to solve myself. And yet, I've met many people that do ask questions and don't solve anything.

My previous girlfriend, for example, kept asking me how to fix our relationship, and she asked it for five years, until, finally, she decided to cheat on me with someone else. At first, she believed to have solved her problem by sleeping with another man but soon realized that he was actually stimulating her memories of me. Their relationship didn't last long because she couldn't love him. But it made her realize how much she loved me.

The real challenge arrives when we're faced with such outcome, because now she is trapped between the humiliation of wanting me back and a relationship that is doomed to end but that she wants to keep merely to satisfy her own pride and need for security.

In both cases, she is being trapped by her own ego, and that's why the ego is the main force pushing us to fulfill our karma.

We often look at the ego and karma as negative things, but that's related to irresponsibility, which is also negative by itself. These 3 elements compose the triangle of self-destruction, from which we emerge as a renewed being after years of struggle and pain.

When she says that we may meet after several years if this relationship doesn't work, she is already subconsciously accepting the fact that she is in a path of learning through self-destruction.

As I said to her, we just need to listen ourselves speaking to truly know what we are doing and attracting.

The ego and karma can be seen as positive, when we form the triangle of conscience, from which the will to be happy demands the responsibility in accepting our own mistakes and the consequences of our actions.

Apart from these facts, and because we tend to manifest by default, reality keeps pushing us forward along the whole way, not allowing us to

see where the path is leading us. And this is what makes conscience such an important topic.

Those who say the universe has its own way don't understand the meaning of spirituality, as to be spiritual is to see more, and you can't see and not act at the same time. Wherever you can see, causes a reaction in you, from which even passivity can lead to a certain action or reaction.

Silence and sound have both a meaning, and we understand the role of which when understanding the meaning of being conscious.

Responsibility and Alchemy

Whenever a person wishes to prolong an action or a relation that seems doomed to end badly, what we're actually witnessing is a situation in which this individual, despite knowing that is creating everything around himself or herself, can't accept responsibility for it and is afraid to change and face all the fears implied in such transformation.

To be responsible and change is also to accept that we hurt others and not many people can deal with the feelings of guilt, shame and blame. It's always easier to start from the beginning, to just destroy everything we have and restart again. Or, at least, so it seems, because it won't work if the conscience behind the manifestation is the same. You can't manifest a different projection in the karmic waters of life by keeping the same type of conscience.

In alchemy, water is related to emotions, and it's one of the four main elements, being fire, earth and air the other three. And so, we can't change our emotions by maintaining the same type of thoughts (air), actions (earth) and fire (desire).

The woman in the story mentioned before doesn't know this and, as everyone that is spiritually immature, thought that changing man would solve her problem, while what it did was change the same paradigm to a new relationship.

If you think that you're loving someone but you're instead giving pain to that person, you won't be able to move to another until you learn to love that first person. And this is a very complex topic that not many people can deal with, but the difficulty is usually related to the concept of love that we have. It's for this reason that people try to suppress love with anger and blame. The two things are so interrelated that only the tears of disappointment and frustration can reveal the real truth beneath any human connection.

Love pushes conscience forward and pain forces the awakening of such conscience. Whenever there is love, there we will find also pain.

Most people think that love is something that simply exists within them, that spontaneously happens and they may even say: "I love you but you don't love me" or "You love me but I can't love you".

From an external point of view, this may seem to make sense but it's not the case, however, from an alchemical perspective. Love is the resulting manifestation from two elements in interaction. If the other represents a two, our reflection of one, then love is the third element, emerging from both.

To be more precise, we tend to attract people that reflect us, and that's why friendships and relationships fail so often. We have difficulties in going back to the first elements and seeing what we're doing, although, seeing it and changing it, also makes those friendships and relationships disappear.

The people we know are always correlated to what we are reflecting. And the emotions we create with them aren't as much related to what is said or thought as to what is felt between both. That specific emotion is a chemical reaction showing the combination between self and the reflection of self.

In fact, it's quite interesting to notice that people tend to see different things on the other, and even interpret different things in a conversation according to their own nature. One sentence can have one meaning to a certain person and a completely different meaning to another. And yet, whatever each one observes, is always related to who they are, to what they must see and acknowledge.

The Emotional Triangle in Alchemy

Love is positive and hate is negative, and there's no other connection more powerful between a number one and a two when we're manifesting a powerful three. That three is the beginning of any change.

The number three is extremely important in an alchemical process, because it sets the beginning of any change. In whatsoever human beings do, there is a third element creating some type of manifestation. The material world is in constant progress, and so, whatever we intimately wish or repel, does manifest according to the power of the desire.

The third element starts with a desire and finishes with a manifestation. For example, if we feel lonely with our marriage and wish a good relationship, we may attract betrayal. The same applies when we desire happiness and our partner can't offer it because he or she isn't happy.

That third element will always strengthen itself, with the opinions of others, unpredictable events and situations, and even specific individuals.

If two people are always arguing between each other, there has to be a third element interfering with their relationship. Two people in love can't hate unless there's a third element pushing the negativity inside the dynamic. It's a very basic rule. The third element may be hidden but always exists behind any conflict, and it's often a person that we thought that loved us, like our best friend or a relative.

From the perspective of the law of attraction, the third element is seen as personal, and it's represented by the connection between mind, heart and actions. But in essence, everyone that fails in applying the law of attraction isn't using one of these three elements properly, or all three combined, in a well-balanced way. You always need motivation, knowledge and actions to make something happen.

When we look at these guiding principles to see how a relationship works, the third element is also what the two individuals are doing to each other in order to manifest their reality. If two persons want to be together, they are promoting love, and that's the third element. So, if they can't, there is a third element, a third person interfering with it.

Alchemically speaking, love changes people, and it's easy to see if we're loved because those changes are either positive or negative. Every single girlfriend I had, became more beautiful, happy and confident after meeting me.

In return, these women gave me pain. But why would a person that receives love give pain to her lover? Pain is an emotion connected to the heart and it's unnatural in love. Therefore, it exists when it's being somehow stimulated. If a person needs something from another, like a marriage, for example, and someone around the couple keeps criticizing one of them for not being married, then that person will emotionally detach from the relationship by resenting the situation and allowing this third element to destroy the dynamic.

We all need to be loved, and so, when we add more elements to the equation, like love and marriage, we make the energetic flow of love less fluid and also less efficient. Conceptualizations are the cause of complexities and distress, not love in itself.

The Alchemical Importance of Love

Love can heal but only when allowed. This allowing occurs in the mind, the first element leading to the second, the relationship. There isn't any love without the three elements.

Regarding this issue, an interesting thing happened with my last girlfriend because, after meeting her new boyfriend, she replied that the reason why she abandoned me was because she needed a marriage that I wasn't offering. And now comes the interesting part of this story, as she got the marriage proposal from that new man but not his love.

She was using her mind to restart a new relationship and failed. And she will fail in every single relationship until she uses the heart. There is never a relationship where there is no heart.

It's also interesting to mention that in our last call, she mentioned that, despite not having love, she believes that it may eventually occur. In other words, she is using the law of attraction to create a relationship with love, as if that was possible.

Love is the guiding energy of the universe and you can't force it, only accept it and use it.

In a relationship, love may manifest as a third element, but it's never meaningful if the relationship in itself has no meaning. In fact, when mentioning that she misses our travelings together and wants to be part of my spiritual group, she is indirectly saying that the energy is pulling her towards me, not him. To deliberately choose to love the wrong man is to neglect the meaning of such energy, an attitude from which many karmic lessons emerge, such as the sensation of loneliness, boredom and depression.

It will take months or years, until these emotions create a hurricane of problems that make her new relationship impossible to persist, and that's why she fears I disappear. Whatever we plant, we shall reap. If we plant winds, we reap storms.

Another thing worth mentioning about this story is related precisely with the triangle itself. If you love one person but sleep with another, you are betraying yourself as well and not only the other individual. That's

why relationships that start with a cheating behavior tend to not last very long.

When a woman loves one man and sleeps with another, she is detaching herself from the triangle, which is a mental reaction leading to a decline in emotional manifestations.

I've heard many stories about failed relationships and the conclusions are always the same. People are never honest because they don't want to admit what they do wrong in their relationships, and the truth is that they have somehow deliberately destroyed them.

The 4th Alchemical Element

The fourth element constitutes the final stage of any manifestation. A three always leads to a four.

Symbolically, the 4th element can form a square or a cross, both symbols of creation in religion, alchemy and science as well.

In the alchemical process, the fourth element is creation itself, the resulting combination of the first three elements.

Between two persons in love, whenever they manifest well the first three elements, a fourth always emerges. So, for example, if we have two people in love and happy with each other, it's very natural that this dynamic may lead to marriage, babies, common projects that are successful, either related to buying a house or creating a family business, or much more than that.

The first three alchemical elements are the only way to predict the success of a relationship. So, if the first three elements include love, the relationship has a successful future. Otherwise, that fourth element will never manifest, unless as self-doubt, eventually corrupting the importance of the first two elements, the individuals involved in the relationship.

Self-doubt is a natural consequence of frustration in building a loving relationship. And that's why nothing remains the same. Whatever we fail at building reverts to us forcing our conscience about the mistakes we do.

People can try to transform an illusion into a reality, but time eventually forces them to see the illusion as it is. And that point, the only thing that remains real is their mistake of leaving the reality they had slip away. All my former girlfriends tried to get me back when, by that time, it was too late already.

My mind, heart and life move at a very fast rhythm as with anyone that vibrates at a very high level. When my conscience shifts, I'm extremely fast at attracting new people to fill the gap. And that's precisely what makes detachment much more painful for me, as I know that I'm always detaching from people that may take years to realize their mistakes and I can't wait so long for them to awake.

After my former girlfriend abandoned me, I immediately met over twenty wonderful women in less than three weeks, most of them unexpectedly on the street, and was persuaded to create a spiritual group, which, after I decided to move forward with the idea, got thirty members in less than just five days. And that's why it's so difficult for me to wait for common humans, which typically move at a very slow rhythm, even slower than the vibration of the planet Earth, to realize the implications of their actions.

The fourth element is what constitutes the evidence of positive balance and that's why society is so obsessed with it. Moreover, the problem often starts here, when people obsess over a fourth element while neglecting the others, because, in many cases, the fourth element can't become a second element.

The role that these elements play in our life really depends on each individual, but we can easily reflect on this topic to see how far it can lead us. For example, when my last girlfriend abandoned me to be with someone else, she was chasing the fourth element while neglecting the third, her love for me, therefore, despite what everyone told me, I was the only one predicting what eventually happened in less than one month, i.e., that they would break up because there was no love.

The only reason that makes her persist in being with him despite the failures they already show in less than one month is shame.

Furthermore, there are many women believing they can love two men, or more, but from an alchemical perspective, this can't happen. I've seen the evidence too many times and predicted the end of many relationships by simply using this basic rule.

If we are merely dealing with friendships, the third element can be, for example, trust. Whenever you're dealing with someone that isn't trustable, you'll never create absolutely anything. It doesn't matter how many efforts you make, how much you trust the other person or like him or her, because if the nature of the other isn't trustable, the third element simply isn't there, and so the fourth will never occur as well.

The 5th Alchemical Element

At the end of any alchemical process, we reach the fifth element, which is considered a magical number. Five is the number of points in the pentagram, a symbol used in many magic rituals.

What makes five so important is precisely the number before it, four, and the one following it, the six.

In cartomancy, the number five is usually associated with a stage of reflection, consideration and conscious procedures. Whenever a person gets a five in a reading, it always portrays something occurring that needs to be taken with care and patience. We just have to ask ourselves what happens and how we feel when we create something to know the importance of this number.

The fifth number isn't always desirable, but it's extremely important to manifest conscience. For example, if two people in love have a son and that son has a disease or dies, that disease or death is a 5th element. That 5th element will force the couple to rethink about their relationship and love. And commonly, when something happens to a son, a couple may breakup.

A breakup doesn't have to happen because of a death, disease or even lack of children, as when one of the members in the relationship can't have babies. The three elements that compose it will still be there.

What makes the number five so special is the magic that it brings forth. When a person can't have a son, this may affect self-esteem, especially in women, and this lack of self-love, so important in our spiritual growth, may affect a relationship, which will just make the process worse. This because, when two people love each other, anything we face is easier than when we're completely alone.

In truth, the 5th element can't be bad in itself, unless someone in the relationship fears the transmutation. And so, for example, if two persons are loving each other, building something together, but one is impatient and wants to force the 5th element to manifest without the cooperation of the partner, the 5th element has to lead to destruction.

This situation is very common when a woman wants to force her boyfriend to marry her and he isn't ready. A wiser woman would look at

the other four elements, instead of letting herself go by external influences damaging the relationship.

Marriage seems to be one of the most important topics in today's society, following money, so I will use both to explain how the 5th element can lead to a positive magical manifestation or negative as well.

If two persons love each other, we are already reaching a fourth element, which means that, if the fifth doesn't manifest, it's because they're failing at the fourth.

In my latest relationship this was very obvious. I needed to focus on my work, stay in one country for at least six months by myself, and my girlfriend needed to travel and couldn't be alone without me, so we kept having arguments, basically because she wanted to force me to marry her and I wasn't ready for it and needed time to focus on my work and get more results first.

In our last and biggest discussion, I literally pushed her out of my life for several months, to focus on my books, and after six months apart, despite receiving her calls every day, she found someone else and decided to leave me.

We were both working on our fourth element, which is good, in the sense that the 5th element was on the way. The only reason why the 5th element ended up representing a final breakup, a cheating behavior, is because there was a rupture in the third and second elements. In other words, she thought I didn't love her, and then, being the second element in the relationship, she consciously decided to leave it.

Conscience is the key word here, as love can't be perceived as positive or negative without a conscience. It's the human conscience that directs or deflects the energy brought forth by other alchemical elements deprived of will.

Alchemy in Love and Relationships

Saying to a person that we love her is as important as making this person believe that it's true. The three elements must exist for a relationship to last.

There are many relationships that start with lust, not love, but lust is also a form of love, although of a lower nature. Lust is the love for bodies and sex. When a person cheats on another that she loves, it's usually related to lust.

The problem with lust is that it's not enough to manifest a strong 3rd element leading to a 4th. People can't do anything together if all they want is just sex.

A relationship that starts with lust either moves to love or fails. There is no other way.

This is also the reason why I knew that every single one of my previous girlfriends that cheated on me would come back. You can't love an illusion and you can't keep a relationship only with lust. Lust is weak in chemical connections between humans and can't last.

One of my female friends once asked me why she can't keep any relationship for too long, and my answer offended her because she wasn't ready to accept it. She always insists in keeping open relationships with men, and so, although she thinks that she's polyamorous and able to love different men at the same time, what she's actually doing is neglecting love and subconsciously focusing on lust.

You can have lust and love but not lust without love. Physical pleasures, like the material reality, are always doomed to change, deteriorate and end. Nothing stays the same. Only love can last forever.

Love is enough to keep two persons together but life isn't static, when the fourth element manifests out of love, both individuals are forced to take decisions, and it's here, at this point, when moving from the fourth to the fifth element, that magic occurs and the unpredictable happens. One may manifest a job in a certain country and the other in another country, and then we have, for example, a relationship in which they are apart, each manifesting their 4th element in the relationship but physically detached from one another.

The less people understand the meaning of love, the more likely this happens. That's why women that keep open relationships tend to find men from different countries, which then forces a physical detachment between both.

When people want a monogamous relationship but don't respect the needs of their partner, the same physical detachment may and will eventually occur.

The external things that test the strength of a relationship aren't as important as the conscience of the couple in understanding the meaning of being in love. The more you understand what love really is, the less you have to worry about it, and the more secure you will feel with your partner.

The fifth element represents conscience regarding the dynamic occurring. So, if people start feeling lonely, unloved, the third element will break. If their job or business isn't working well, the 4th element also starts breaking. And we only need one of the persons in the relationship to lose his job for it to affect the dynamic. Because, if one of the individuals fails in his 4th element, the other is building his alone, but we can't move to a 5th stage without risking a complete destruction.

This is also the case when one of the individuals is unemployed for a long period of time and the other starts feeling used and abused. Here, the lack of a common 4th element leads to the destruction of the third, which is lack of love.

We may then ask what is love and why we can't just love the ones we want. And this is indeed an excellent topic of discussion, because, despite all the emotions and feelings that love brings to our life, it actually starts in the mind. Love is the manifestation of conscious energy.

Think about this for a while: If you go out at night and people from the opposite gender start approaching you, will you choose any? Obviously not, there is a criteria, and your criteria becomes known when you are faced with the need to choose. The more relationships we have, the more conscious we are of what we need, of what kind of person fits us better.

Unfortunately, this typically means failing many times, in many relationships, until we are aware of it.

At the end, the person we choose to be our lover, the one we accept from the reality manifesting to us, brings a story with him or her, so what we truly love is as much the experience we feel within us coming to manifestation as it is the personal perception of that individual.

From a number one perspective, we can only love another person after loving ourselves, and we can only know who to love after knowing what we need.

The Spiritual Importance of Love

Real love starts with admiration. We admire the ones that manifest what we wish for ourselves, as well as those that make us feel proud.

Admiration works in both ways, so, for example, men want to be admired by being seen with a beautiful and friendly woman, and women want to be admired by being seen with a beautiful and friendly man. In both cases, this admiration is related to recognition, a third element.

Another third element could be the projection of our inner desires. Whatever we need becomes loved when seen. So, if a woman needs a rich husband, she may believe to be falling in love with a man that has money. And the same applies to certain emotions, like respect, happiness, etc.

Obviously, within these concepts that we need, there may also be others that we reject, and sometimes they are the same. For example, if a woman wants to be happy but can't accept happiness due to her own self-inflicted pain related to a past that she hasn't solved, namely, past breakups that aren't yet healed, then she can't love anyone else, as she's living in contradiction.

When women constantly change from one relationship to another, thinking that the problem is in the man they find, they're basically running away from themselves.

Whenever I saw this situation manifesting in women that couldn't be happy with me, it was extremely easy to make them want me back, because I suddenly realized it wasn't love that attracted them to me but pain. The more I offended them and gave them painful words, the more they wanted me back. In fact, they were smart enough to know how to provoke me into reacting in such way.

That's obviously a distorted perception of love but is extremely common with women that are unhappy with themselves. They may say to a previous boyfriend that they love him while sleeping with another, as they feed from the pain of others. And that's their third element, that's how they diminish their own sense of guilt and frustration.

It would be normal to affirm that everyone desires happiness, but the truth is that a person that isn't happy can't. She will destroy her own

relationships without realizing it. At the end, she will only be able to look at reactions, not her responsibility in the process.

Happiness is in the 1st alchemical element, our desire, the 2nd, what we admire in the other, the 3rd, the love between both, and the 4th, the experiences shared together. But as soon as we reach the fifth element, happiness becomes the need for more, and it is at this point that the happiness shared might not be enough.

If a woman can't be happy, she'll always seek for happiness in something more than her own relationship, by traveling more, meeting more men and demanding more things from her lover. She'll always project a need for happiness, because she can't see it in any of the previously mentioned four elements.

Often what happens is that people aren't conscious of their own life, and so, they move from the 1st alchemical element to the 5th without any awareness whatsoever, and then are surprised when the 5th element brings forth destruction.

This statement can easily be proven when you tell others how they offend you and they show themselves surprised, as the most aggressive individuals are commonly completely unaware of what they're doing to others and how they influence them.

There's a huge weakness in the first element, the conscience of self, whenever there is pain. And it's as sad to say it as it is challenging, because there's only one way to help such individuals, and it consists in loving them despite the amount of pain they give us in return.

It's extremely difficult to love someone that, for example, betrays, but the dramatic side of it is that this is the only way they'll ever have a chance to be normal again and maintain any relationship in their life.

This kind of sacrifice may lead to the death of the one sacrificing himself, but this is what love truly means. When a priest risks his own life to perform an exorcism, he is offering the ultimate sacrifice, his life in exchange for the soul he wants to rescue.

The 6th Alchemical Element

There isn't necessarily a 6th element in the alchemical transmutation of reality, at least, not from a magical perspective, because this 6th element is always associated with choice and change. The 6th element is the resulting consequence of how we deal with the 5th.

As an example, if a woman desires happiness and meets a man that gives her that, she falls in love with him. Then, her happiness projects a fourth element, their life together and dreams for the future, and so, she desires to live with this man, become intimate with him, share things and thoughts with him.

The fourth element will seem perfect until one point, when she becomes obsessed with a fifth. Because the fifth element must occur as naturally as the previously four and that's often not the case.

The reason why so many people have problems with the 5th element, and end up divorcing, is related to the tendency that we see in modern society for materialism and the need to consume beyond our means.

The fourth element is material, beyond conscience, admiration and love, and easily deceives people. Human beings judge what they see based on what they know, therefore, as soon as they see the fourth element, they immediately project a 5th themselves, without even considering if the 4th is solid enough.

We can easily see this in love and relationships. A person projects, admires the one that she attracts, loves him, and then we have the 4th element, a life and dreams in common. At this point, he or she wants more, a marriage, a house, etc. The individual becomes emotionally greedy and needy.

Nevertheless, the problem only begins when one wants alone and not with the other. For example, when a woman wants to live in one country and her boyfriend wants another, when they have different views on what they should do and each wants to change the other. Here, the fourth element brings the 5th down. That is to say, the lack of a solid fourth collapses the fifth and questions the third.

Within the 3rd element, when one or both start questioning their love, anything can happen to destroy it. At this stage, if another person enters

the equation as a third physical element, a possible cheating opportunity, then that love is definitely threatened and may end.

It's much easier to be jealous than to learn how to love, and that's why modern couples tend to be more obsessed with controlling their partner instead of building a solid relationship.

The Relation between the 3rd and 6th Elements

In my story, my former girlfriend cheated with another man while still loving me. After that, she kept loving me, and even saw her new relationship quickly deteriorating for that reason. However, what she did, killed my love for her. The third element was broken.

Now, she loves alone, she is within the conscience of the first element, her own self and its needs, because I don't exist to her as a second element except in her imagination.

She may even keep having a relationship with that man or start others, but until the first element is fixed, which demands introspection in loneliness, she'll never be able to love anyone else, especially if the memories of us are still solid inside her mind.

It's for this reason that women with emotional baggage struggle to make their future relationships work. It's never about the new relationship, the reconstruction of the 3rd element, but the fact that, without strong roots planted on the ground, no tree can stand a storm. And those roots are planted in the subconscious, our emotional identity, our spiritual conscience of who we are as a soul.

This woman won't ever be capable of loving another man, no matter how many times she tries, not until she solves her problems with herself, and that's the irony of life. Love helps a person in dealing with anything, but if we love alone, then there is no love anymore but only conscience.

To love our conscience without a reflection of it, an external source of love, is quite difficult, and that's why this woman, like many others, is constantly seeking for new relationships. Those that fear themselves are constantly running away from their own shadow like a madman thinking he can escape himself.

In this case, she will have to deal with her problem without love. In between her new relationships and within herself, when in moments of loneliness, she'll spend plenty of time with her own conscience. She will feel lonely with or without a man in her bed because that's the karma she has accumulated by deliberate choice.

The memories of her past affairs emerging from her sense of loneliness, as well as the emotions that they'll trigger, will push her conscience and force her to move upwards through the fire of remorse and guilt. In fact, when she tells me that her new boyfriend awakens the memories of our relationship, she's already unknowingly admitting the effect of this theory on her life. Because, from an alchemical point of view, what is truly happening is a transmutation of the soul through its own self-inflicted pain.

The sad truth about her and that most human beings like her can't accept is that, until her conscience allows seeing why she can't love another soul, she may have dozens of relationships and fail in each one of them despite any efforts.

As a matter of fact, if she achieves a marriage or becomes a mother, this karma will just become even more painful to endure. You just have to imagine the pain of being a single mother or trapped in a failed marriage to understand my point.

Karmically speaking, it wouldn't be surprising to find her, years from now, raising a son and married to a husband that never sleeps at home. That's what happens when women push the 4th and 5th element without a first or third, as the second, the husband, will vanish too from their equation of life.

It is relatively easy to identify the spiritual focus of each individual by looking at what triggers their attention. People that have a weak first element, are always seduced by activities and those that can make them better, more competitive, smarter and more beautiful. They will never react to activities related to second and third elements, like empathy and love.

This girlfriend, for example, followed everything I said about how to make more money and become more attractive to the opposite gender. She never accepted anything related to making me happier or create more love among us. And I wouldn't be surprised to know that the new man in her life seduced her by offering her a deceptive dream, an illusion, because she had to be a fool to fall for it so easily.

On the other hand, she was surprised to see that I don't pay attention and won't respond to attempts to control me at the first element, that is, I won't respond to emails where she offers me trips to a new country I want to visit or tries to find me by using things I need to do or have. I can't be bought or manipulated because my first element is strong. It wouldn't make sense otherwise, as these books emerge precisely from the first element, an honest conscience about myself and life in general.

A person can only attract me with the 3th, 4th and 5th elements, namely, love, help and dreams. Indeed, she only had to love me, let me finish my books and dream a future for our relationship to work. And this seems simple, but it's never that easy for those suffering from lack of awareness. They fear everything, including themselves, and eventually self-destroy with their own arrogance, insecurities and need for revenge.

At the end, fools behave like fools, by following illusions that lead them to hell on earth and plenty of suffering.

When Buddha mentioned that illusions are the cause of all suffering, he was explaining this, and yet, few still understand. When this woman says to others that she is a Buddhist, it's as if she was publicly promoting herself as a fool.

There is more reality and wisdom in the one that can admit his own faults. And this book couldn't be written without a full awareness of this fact, at the first element, as that's what I do when accepting my mistakes and analyzing the third element from a second element perspective, which is indeed a reflection of self. Her foolishness forced me to see mine. And to think that a fool won't behave like a fool, is part of my own foolishness. One fool chased an illusion and the other chased the first fool, and so both are fools. She had to leave my life for me to awake or this book would have never been written.

The Alchemical Laws of Wealth and Love

The alchemical steps to create wealth can be seen as a personal process of manifestation or socially combined. We can also analyze it from different perspectives.

With a single person, wealth is first seen as conscience. The person must desire more wealth and abundance in his or her life. The second element is manifested in our actions, what we do and what we want to do. And this second element will lead to a third, our results, in which we will then be confronted with what we need to improve. It can be related to making more social connections, learn more, travel, etc. Whatever is the case, the third element always manifests a change of conscience.

The fourth element is the physical reality. This manifestation occurs in the amount of money we make, the reactions of others and how we deal with all that.

Even though many people envy my capacity to make a good living from books, it wasn't always like this. For many years I earned very little, and I was obviously criticized by every single girlfriend I had. Their reaction was as important as the amount of money I was making, because, in both cases, I was facing material manifestations of a 4th element, the material reality of what I was creating.

At a certain moment, I had to accept that I had to change the way I looked at what I was doing, I had to start looking at the books as any other business, I had to start investing in promoting them, and reorganize them in a way that could lead to more sales. I literally had to change myself from a writer to a businessman.

That 4th element led to a fifth, and that's the projection of what I was really doing, where I wanted to go. And so, the women that tried to stop me from writing books when I wasn't making enough money and mainly for this reason, eventually left my life by themselves, one way or another, after our relationship collapsed.

They were attacking my fourth element, which was also their fourth element, as most women can't accept a boyfriend as being a struggling

artist. Life had to take them away, even if they think their affair was normal and their need to return to me after cheating too.

First, they cheated because they couldn't accept the 4th element, then they broke the 3rd element and, finally, they wondered why the 2nd element, me, was never going to return to their life, or why the 5th, marriage, was impossible to get.

I persisted so much in my work that, with or without a girlfriend, with happiness or depression, it had to manifest its results. And so it happened, and I ended up alone in Spain, with a beautiful house, lots of money, a swimming pool, wonderful beaches, and living by myself in a big empty house and in a wonderful city.

Paradise is indeed a lonely place because most people are deliberately creating their own hell.

My point with this story is that, when you really want something, the others are either with you or against you. If the women that loved me supported me, they would now be with me, but because they didn't, I ended up with everything but alone.

On another hand, if I followed their dreams, I would probably be married by now and doing something else with my life, having a job from 9 to 5 instead of writing this book in front of the ocean and under a wonderful afternoon sunshine with a cooling breeze in the air.

The Challenge of the 6th Element

In alchemy, with a fifth comes a sixth choice, and I always choose to follow my own dreams, my 5th element. I keep reinforcing my own spiritual pentagram of life. And this, maybe, because I have suffered too much in the past to allow anyone to bring me down again.

This said, I am as guilty of losing opportunities for marriage as they are for what they do, although I never tried to make their 4th element collapse, I never tried to stop them from doing what they wanted. Maybe if I did, we would end up married and that's also the irony of fate.

To exemplify my explanation, one of my friends married a supermodel that was traveling the world doing what she loved. He told her that he would only marry her if she quitted her job and so she did. She sacrificed the fourth element to get a fifth and now works in an office, as a secretary, doing something she dislikes.

Their marriage persists because there is still love between them and a life in common, the forth element, and that's why the fifth remains strong.

It's true that selfishness is as important as love to guarantee its strength. When we tell another person that we love him or her, we are strengthening the emotional connection between both, as love shouldn't need words to justify itself. What is the meaning of love when the person claiming to love is sleeping with someone else and sharing life with him? If such person truly believes in what she says, then she is deeply and mentally sick, and as much as a psychopath that thinks he is doing a favor to the world and God by murdering.

It's also true that we may have to compromise and lose things to keep a relationship and manifest a marriage, but that's part of the magic in the number five. How much are we willing to sacrifice at the stage of four will dictate how five will manifest the new reality.

In many cases, love is enough, and to exemplify this affirmation we have the stories of the many billionaires whose wife merely had to be by their side during their difficult moments of pain, suffering and struggle. Commonly, these men were completely broke and merely supported by

their girlfriend, until something happened, an idea became a success and suddenly they became extremely wealthy.

When this happens, the woman that was loving a very poor man becomes very rich by simply loving him and then marrying him.

On the other hand, it's precisely during these challenging moments that the ones we love the most leave us.

I struggled for years to have the life I have now and it was precisely at the moment that my income increased by twenty times more and I started living in a beautiful city that my former girlfriend found someone else.

This was predictable because she wasn't supporting my efforts. I had to spend entire days in coffee shops just to avoid her many attempts to stop me and make me change my focus to something else, like a new job.

The outcome was alchemically expectable. She was acting as a challenge, a counter force, and as soon as I won, she vanished because her relationship with me made no more sense. She entered my life to defeat me and not to strengthen me. My strength had to come from within, from the reinforcement of the first element, the conscience of what I really wanted and was willing to sacrifice to get.

I can say that I sacrificed her but not as much as she volunteered herself to be sacrificed.

Not many women can see it but they do have a very important role in a man's life. They often are so focused on the number one, what they want, that they fail in perceiving that they can help their man create an amazing four, and from that level gain their five, the magic of a beautiful and happy life in common.

Surely, a person can become rich on his own but it's much easier when we are being loved. Love projects energy from us and through our inner self.

In a business, for example, our partners don't have to be in love with us, but trust, encouragement and common goals must manifest for the 5th element to lead to a fortune.

The Relation Between the 5th and 6th Elements

Whenever the 5th element creates its magic, we are put in front of a decision, and that's represented by the number six, the two options we face. After that, we go back to ground one, the beginning of a new conscience, the restart of a karmic cycle, the rebirth of a new and renewed will, the beginning of a new karmic wheel.

It's relatively easy to illustrate how the 6th element manifests with many stories, because the 6th element is always related to the connection between the 1st, our conscious desires, but also the 5th, the manifestation of changes in our magnetic field.

If I meet a girl that I admire and she admires me too, we fall in love. And so far so good, as the 3rd element will be strong between us.

This manifestation leads us to consider that we can stay together with our partner for many years, reason why people never imagine that their relationships can collapse soon after they fall in love.

The problem is that the 3rd element can't stay as a 3rd for too long, and so we move to the 4th, as our business, love and relationships evolve in different directions and we have to compromise and make choices.

In my personal story, my former girlfriend manifested opportunities in the USA and I manifest them in Spain, and so, we manifest two lives apart. We could still meet but we were physically apart.

This world is physical, not just energetic, and that's why we tend to be pushed to depart from our emotional connections whenever the physical side of our existence is moved in space.

Long distance relationships can work for as long as the distance becomes what both compromise with, that is, something that both accept. But this wasn't the case for her, as she felt lonely (3rd element breaking) and afraid to fail in her business (4th element breaking), and so she started questioning my love for her (2nd element breaking). At the end, she was alone with her own conscience (1st element) and kept crying because of her own fears related to things that wouldn't happen unless she created them herself, like me abandoning her forever.

Despite the facts, the 5th element was there too, at least from a relationship point of view, as our love and daily communications would eventually lead to a new reencounter. But if one of the members in the relationship is breaking the 5th element, this 5th will lead to a 6th related to a choice between ending or keeping such connection. That 6th element was the illusion, a man that she imagined to be perfect for her. She could't resist him and in her despair failed in everything, including in what she was expecting from him.

The immediate reaction that I had when she told me that she had chosen a new person was: "Can't you see that he was just there as a test and that relationship will never work?"

She obviously didn't agree because she thought that she was in love, that this man was a better option than me, but time proved me right, once again, because in less than one month their relationship was showing obvious signs of never going anywhere.

People, and especially women that betray me, in their arrogance, do insist in trying to prove me wrong because they can't deal with the fact that I'm always right in my predictions. They do this from an egotistical point of view, unaware that I'm merely interpreting the laws of God, not creating them myself.

Despite all the books I write about this topic, people still insist in thinking that I'm wrong, that they know what they are doing, just because I can't see it, just because I'm not there. But a test is what a test is, and she simply couldn't build a relationship from a test, even if she tried really hard, as I'm sure she did and keeps doing.

Life doesn't work like this and life isn't subjected to human arrogance and egotistical will.

Life has its own perfection within which we are either in or out. And so, she followed her illusion and like a fool ended lost and confused. But I followed my own truth and did something that wouldn't be possible if I was still dreaming about being with her, which was to create my own religious community.

The irony of fate is that she could have been part of it and now will have to find another way on her own, probably seeking gurus that have absolutely no idea of what they're saying, as she lived a relationship with a real one, a bestselling author of spiritual books, and couldn't see it.

She's spiritually blind and reminds me of the people I encounter in religious meetings but never believe that I write spiritual books. The blind can follow gurus and religion, and even learn many techniques for meditation, and still remain blind. I have seen them in abundance.

It's impossible to see the truth without an open heart, and that's why God only reveals his wisdom, his secrets, to a few. God has its plan but it doesn't include fools. In the house of God there is no room for fools.

The Alchemical Explanation for Breakups

If one of the members in a relationship is enforcing the five elements but the other is destroying them, the relationship would be manifesting its own challenge, the 6th element.

For example, before my latest breakup, I was systematically approached by women that wanted to have intercourse with me, and this happened for years, even weeks before my ex-girlfriend decided to leave me, but I consciously refused them as I didn't want to break the love link with my girlfriend. However, she, on the other hand, failed at the first challenge encountered.

Simply putting it, some people are too weak to know what they are doing. They may regret it when it's too late already but that's why they keep repeating the same mistakes.

In our last phone call she said: "I don't know why all my relationships fail".

Simple answer: "Because you don't love anyone".

A relationship is a combination of two persons cooperating for the manifestation of five elements that must be equal between one another. That magic must be worked towards the same purpose. One person alone can't build a relationship for two.

The same applies to success in life. Most people want money, the 5th element, and think that the law of attraction will do miracles for them, but without the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th, there is not 5th, there is no magic.

What could be the first four elements? The 2nd is a reflection of what is being done, the 3rd is self-awareness based on the results, the 4th is in the improvements and the 5th is the magic.

I've helped many people in their business by simply following these principles. My ex-girlfriend, for example, was helped in this way. She may never realize it but she became very successful based on what I taught her. First, I taught her how to take notes of what she's doing and build a website, so that she can get the 2nd element, a perception of the work being conducted, the reflection that in a relationship becomes the

other and his feedback, and that when we are alone is our own metacognition. Then, I taught her how to believe in herself despite any outcome, as the first results she was getting weren't good.

That confidence that I empowered on her was what forced her to insist on working on that number 3, and so, she soon manifested the 4th, in the form of ideas and opportunities, leading to a 5th, which was success.

Without me, she would doubt herself (break of one), doubt her decisions (break of two), and doubt her clients (break of three), and so, that's also how I know that she'll soon become bankrupt (break of four), as she doesn't have me to help her reach the 5th element, and she's not wise enough to deal with a 6th, i.e., know how to make a good choice.

This is quite obvious, taking into account that we manifest the same patterns in everything we do in life. If, between two men, she doesn't know which one is the best and does the mistake of following the illusion instead of the heart, then with her business the same will happen. Moreover, she's already losing thousands of dollars rapidly, although still thinking that she can beat the system.

I have predicted the future of so many people that I'm still surprised at how arrogant human beings keep insisting on being, as it's precisely this arrogance and selfishness that self-destroys them.

I've already predicted her bankruptcy a long time ago as I predicted her recent affair, reason why I never married her. I couldn't risk marrying a person before knowing if she could be faithful. One prediction happened already and the other is happening at this moment, exactly in the country where she thought she would be rich, the USA. And how ironic that people fail the most when logic leads them to believe otherwise.

Many people do think that the power of thought conquers anything, that the law of attraction and positive thinking is enough to create everything and attract success in business and relationships, and I wrote this book, as many others, to prove them wrong. The law of attraction without karma is irresponsibility and without God is arrogance. And so, whenever you impose your will arrogantly and irresponsibly you have the triangle of catastrophe.

Will without God is self-destructive, as the ego always collapses against its own creation. People self-destroy themselves when they don't obey the natural laws that God created for them. And these laws are

found in almost all religious writings, because they are the same for thousands of years and even before that.

To understand my point, you just have to cut an apple in two, as there you will find the same structure of our planet and universe. The Devine energy manifests equally from the smallest to the biggest materialization.

Furthermore, you must consider that flowers need water as much as we humans need a well-balanced alchemy in our life. A rebel flower or a rebel branch in a tree can never survive on its own. The fruits of our actions are always interconnected with the roots of honesty towards our inner self. The liar is an enemy to himself.

Symbolism, Futurology and Divination

There are many ways of applying the principles of alchemy to predict the future in any given situation, and they're always correlated to the law of opposites as described by Taoism.

These opposites aren't necessarily contrary to themselves as they complement when guiding to the manifestations we perceive. For example, illusion and dream are two opposites, as one leads to deception and the other to realization but, at a first stage, they're exactly the same thing, as anything that hasn't yet materialized is invisible, unreal to anyone else.

For many people, love is an illusion and marriage a reality, and so they do believe that, until they are married, their love is an illusion. And the same applies to a job or a business in which individuals believe that their worth is associated with something material as having a promotion or more money in the bank account.

Obviously, until a person earns enough money to validate himself, has to follow an illusion, and the difference between calling it an illusion or a dream is usually unclear for others until something actually proves the value of such thought or idea, and commonly many years later after it started being pursued.

In many cases, pentagrams can be and are used in magic to manifest the good and the evil. Magic can indeed lead to something good or bad depending on the intention behind the will of its user.

In his works, Da Vinci has shown how these laws correlate to lead to beauty, an ultimate good purpose. But beauty is a self-perceived concept, as we can't truly judge a manifestation except in its relation to our own existence, and this is why the guiding force of a good purpose is always survival, being the best solution presented the survival of the species or humanity as a whole.

Our body, in itself, is a representation of a living pentagram, being our legs related to space, the hands to action and the mind to conscience.

Action is associated with time, as we can be as slow or fast in what we do. Space is connected to our sphere of influence, which can be as direct as our selfish desires or as expansive as the whole world.

Conscience, in itself, is what directs energy, and so, love enhances conscience and empowers it with motivation. A person that works hard, is motivated to do something big and fast, and does everything with happiness, is destined to achieve amazing results in his life and create magic in the physical the world.

We can predict how much a person can or can't do based on this principle, and that's how much someone can manifest. The more powerful one is, the more he or she can manifest, and vice-versa, as the person with less energy and will should focus on smaller actions in order to achieve a certain goal later in time. Persistence always favors the one who is weak.

A smaller goal isn't necessarily less important than a big one, because step by step, we can always reach high goals. A big journey starts with a first and small step. As an example, persistence is the ability to insist in something that takes time to materialize. The one that is persistent is gradually building his future, even though it often seems difficult to achieve. And yet, that future is nothing more than a dream being brought to present.

People that quit quickly tend to focus on things that are too far from their reach and this applies to anything in their life, not only goals, but also love. Women that aren't persistent in their relationships, want to violate the 4th element, forcing their boyfriend to marry them, and then end up collapsing everything, namely, the love among the couple.

Their anxiety is related to fear and fear is correlated to lack of happiness or motivation and ability to pursue significant actions. My previous girlfriend, for example, wanted to marry me, but couldn't accept me as being a writer, therefore violating the 4th element. But was also dramatically failing on the 3rd as she didn't know how to love.

I did many efforts to reinforce the love between us but she couldn't accept it, she couldn't relax near me, didn't like to enjoy walks on the beach and, whenever we were alone, she would look at her books instead of talking to me. She was violating and neglecting the 3rd element entirely, which, on the other hand, made her even more anxious about the 5th, marriage. She wanted to force the 5th element while neglecting the 3rd and 4th, and so, the 2nd, our relationship, had to be broken, as it ended up happening when we moved to different countries and eventually broke-up.

One thing led to another but the events aren't as important as the manifestation of the five elements altogether. We can predict absolutely

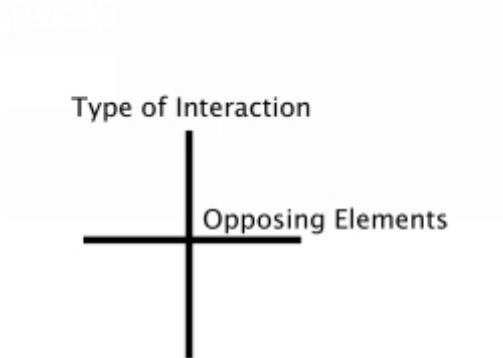
anything by looking at them, because one always follows the other, and to jump them is to violate this law.

Many people may choose to believe that the universe has its own way, that there is a meaning in everything, but that meaning, that law of the universe, is always within us. Nothing that happens is separated from our exteriorizations. The end of a relationship is as meant to happen as the actions of the ones involved in it cause it to happen. What you fear and what you desire isn't separated from the desires and fears of the universe towards your own existence.

The Relation Between the 4th and 5th Elements

The number four is a powerful number, and although not often used for magic rituals, it's important when we want to predict what kind of magic the number five will show us.

There are two ways to do this, either by using a square or a cross. If we're using a cross, we are dealing with opposites. So, for example, the left and right side of the cross represent opposing elements, while the upper and lower show elements that define their type of interaction.



The most simple way to see the left and right sides of the cross is as past and future. If the past is good, the future can only be bad if the upper and lower elements aren't balanced between each other, namely, when a woman cheats on her boyfriend by having sex with a man she doesn't love. Such relationships can't ever work and it's statically proven that they're doomed to fail, simply because the reason why they start in the first place is to escape an emotional challenge, which then ends up reverting to the new partner with far more strength than before.

The stronger the fear, the deeper the desire, but desire in itself emerges always from fear, and therefore, the more we wish for something, the more we fear its opposite. That's why women that fear being abandoned invest so much in their new relationships that end up becoming obsessed about it, eventually destroying it with such obsession. The more we fear something, the more we obsess over its opposite, and the more we obsess, the less results we get, which eventually leads to more fear and a stronger obsession. Fears will always catch up with us, and if not with a previous relationship, with the next, reason why, in time, we end up seeing the same signs we are already familiar with manifesting in a new partner.

The upper and lower elements of the symbolic cross can also be represented as the man and woman going in different directions and pursuing different goals, or merely their thoughts and emotions. So, for example, if my girlfriend is trying to manipulate me into living with her and can't accept my own needs, she's creating an unbalance in which the movement from past to future will lead to a transference from good to bad, as what actually happened between us in my last relationship, because we started fighting more after being apart.

From another angle, looking now at emotions and thoughts, the same thing occurs. If one person doubts the love of the other, there is already unbalance at the lower element of the cross, and this if we're correlating heart and mind.

Such situation can be corrected with the upper element, the mind, but if one of them isn't mature enough, then the collapse is imminent. And, in fact, this was also verified in my situation, because I kept explaining to my girlfriend that I was always alone, working, and even talking to her on the phone everyday, but she couldn't feel at peace. Despite all the evidences that her mind could perceive, her heart was afraid, as she was afraid to end alone, and so, she manifested the future that ended up happening.

The Egyptian cross, also known as ankh is a good representation of such dynamics, because at the upper level we find the symbol for conscience, showing us that whatever happens and whatever we choose in life, is always determined by conscience.

Conscience is cyclical, and with every cycle we revert to a different manifestation, a different passage and transformation. It is for this same reason that the yin and yang symbol of Taoism is shown in a circle as well as the wheel of life in Buddhism.



The dramatic side of my personal story is that, by running away from her fears, my ex-girlfriend created an even greater unbalance between her own heart and mind, and so, she ended in a relationship that completely traps her inside her own mind, a major illusion that she can't awake from and may never anytime soon. The way she talks about her new boyfriend has everything to do with illusive manifestations and nothing to do with emotions or love. In fact, she believes that her relationship is working relatively well because there is no love, which is even more sad, as she can't see that the imminent collapse shown already in less than one month, unveils a dark and painful future that she can't escape from.

It is obvious by her own words that she is confusing the failure with hope, lack of emotions with easier love, and conscience with illusion, therefore allowing the growth of the impact that this karma will have on her.

Her strong desire to keep me as a friend is as much a contradiction as it is a desperate call for help in a person that can't be helped, as she's voluntarily creating her own painful future. By the time she realizes what happened, she'll be facing a much bigger and darker fear, a much dramatic solitude.

Fears never abandon us but they get stronger if we feed them. And running away is feeding the fear. As soon as it becomes big enough, it comes with a vengeance, and this is what will happen to her as soon as she realizes that she lost both relationships. As a matter of fact, when she told me that she had found hundreds of unanswered calls in his phone but still wants to be with him to, in her own words: "see if the relationship can work" she's already assuming a self-destructive attitude towards her own life.

It is said that the ones that hurt us the most need more love and compassion than anyone else, but it's nearly impossible to save someone that has decided to destroy her own life. Whatever we say to such people, they will always do the opposite.

The Illusion of Choice

We may think that people always have a choice but this isn't necessarily true when they're strongly manifesting their own reality. For example, fear is a very powerful energy, and so, the fear of being alone projects the need to find someone that fills this gap. Once this person appears, we can fill the gap so perfectly that it's impossible to refuse the opportunity.

In the previous example, despite the fact that we had been talking on the phone for months and happy with each other, as soon as we had a major fight, that new man appeared exactly in the following day. There was no coincidence and she was in such a major pain that couldn't refuse him. We do defeat ourselves when we least expect.

It's relatively easy to predict the future of our relationship by looking at these elements, but we should always look first at what we are doing. For example, we can look at our past relationship and see if the present one can match our ideal relationship for the future. If the answer is yes, we should observe our mind and heart, to see what we are doing wrong to make it work again.

The mind will have to learn to accept the other person, understand her or his needs, and learn to satisfy the other person, make him or her happy. The heart has to give and receive love but also endure pain.

Sometimes, the best way to love someone is simply to not react to her or his manifestations of anger. Any reaction leads to a counter-reaction, and that's why when we think that we are helping someone, we may be actually pushing that person away, into another karmic cycle, much more difficult to accept.

Our relationship also failed in this aspect as I never wanted to feed any anger between us but she couldn't contain herself and would turn into an abusive person, both orally and physically. If someone feeds pain and thinks about rejection, the future becomes obviously clear.

We can then say whatever we want about it but nothing justifies what we actually do. For example, this woman kept telling me that all her boyfriends cheated on her. I didn't, but she cheated on me. In other words, she proved what this book is describing, i.e., that it doesn't matter

who cheats because when a relationship is doomed to break it will through the weakest link.

Apart from this, we are also dealing with a paradigm and paradigms are powerful. Her paradigm will now lead her into a situation in which she will be cheated. All evidences point at this direction.

I wasn't the weakest link between us and that's why she wanted to marry me. She knew from the beginning that I was trustworthy, that I would never cheat on her, and so she felt safe. But feeling safe is an illusion, especially when we're self-destroying a relationship. And so, she was actually the one cheating on me and doing what others have done to her.

Although the previous example is about love, it can be applied to money too. If you don't like your work, and you don't try to be efficient at what you do, you can expect to lose your job. What is happening today in the world can be attributed to the economic situation but it isn't as much related to a lack of jobs, as it is correlated to an identity crisis among people. The world is going through a major alchemical transmutation.

In our personal life, for money to flow in abundance, the mind and heart must be connected to what we do, whatever it is. Only then can we accept any change with confidence, because it always shifts from good to better.

Nothing stays the same, so we're either evolving or declining. A relationship between two persons is either going forward towards the manifestation of common dreams, or backwards, towards self-doubts, manipulation of will, deceptions and illusions.

If one person is moving in one direction, and the other is acting as a counter-force, as soon as the first succeeds, the second will somehow disappear. Two people in a relationship can only succeed together or fail together. There is no other way.

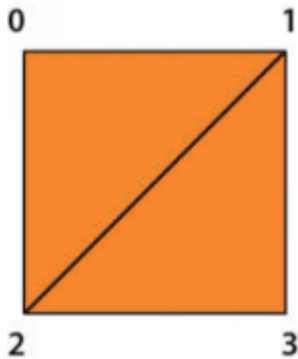
In a business partnership, the same occurs. We are either trusting or distrusting, working together for the same end, or apart for our selfish needs.

The Two Triangles in a Square

The principle of the square works in a similar way as the one of the cross. This symbol exists merely as a way to help us in our perception of reality and through a new perspective.

The first thing we must keep in mind is that a four always leads to a five, so the square exists merely to teach us how, like a triangle pointing at a certain direction. In fact, the square is a combination of two or four triangles, and it's worth to keep this in mind in order to understand how and which 3 elements are leading to a certain forth in order to predict what the 5th will magically manifest.

To see this we just have to connect the 4 angles of the square to find these triangles. So, for example, if we're dealing with a relationship, each angle represents a dynamic of the manifestation in process. We may have person A, person B, love and what is happening between both, which may be, among any other things, an argument.



Let's consider the triangle on the left as being me and the one on the right as being my ex-girlfriend. In common we have 1 and 2, which is the love and the argument. Zero is my conscience and the number 3 hers.

My conscience about our love is that it will never end, and my conscience of the argument is that it is temporary. Therefore, my conscience tells me to focus on my work and leave her apart for a while.

This positive attitude can't break the square but, by looking at her triangle, things appear quite different. She believed I would never be with her again, that my explanation of wanting to focus on new books was just an excuse to meet other women. She also believed that she wasn't being loved. So, her conscience told her that she could end alone if not finding another man rapidly. She broke the square in two triangles.

Another way to look at it consists in using probabilities, that is, to see how many positive and negative elements is the triangle manifesting. In this case, we have 1, the argument and 3, her negative conscience about the relationship.

It may seem that there is a 50/50 chance to keep the relationship, but this type of probability isn't safe to work with, as life never remains the same. The major tendency of the energies of the planet is to break whatever tends to crystalize in time and remain permanent, in order to transform the elements into a more subtle matter.

Nevertheless, it's worth mentioning that I suddenly, and just before she slept with a new man, broke the 3rd element by getting angry at her, and so, now we have 0, 1 and 3, 75% of the relationship ending.

As weird as it may seem to say it like this, she actually had 25% of chances to say no to the new man and, interestingly, they fitted perfectly into the number 2. In other words, her new boyfriend was a new zero, a new me, number 1 manifested, because he was nice to her, and number 2 wasn't there because he didn't love her. So, what did 3 do? 3 did what 3 desired: a new opportunity.

The relationship between them failed because the 2 never existed. But can a relationship fail with 25% of chances? No, other 2 elements must manifest for the three of them, simultaneously, lead to their breakup in less than one month. And so, the only reason why she keeping being with him is shame, the egotistical will to keep something doomed to finish.

They can still try to maintain and prolong this relationship, because what they're actually doing is keeping something that doesn't really exist, and that's why there is no love now and there will be none in the future. The love she feels for me will act as a counter-force as soon as I

finish my own alchemical transmutation in the process of alchemically detaching from her.

The number 3, that previously desired that man, regretted it, because love for the previous man, number 2, was still there, and can't change because it's trapped inside two worlds.

Whenever we are trapped between two realities, and from a karmic perspective, what is happening is a process of accumulation of karma, from which, once the two magnetic fields break apart, that karma creates a 3rd element, unique in itself. And that's her own complete failure in keeping or even getting any type of relationship. She will end alone until this karma is paid or in deep pain every time she avoids it by restarting a new relationship.

This said, they had to fail in either zero or one, or both. And as she eventually told me, he didn't like to know that she still loved me, so his conscience started drifting away, and the number one was merely the material side of their relationship, which either became boring or conflictive.

Again, we can predict what would happen here, because it had to break exactly on the number one. And it will, when she decides to leave the United States and go back to her home country, China, reason why she has been delaying it for many weeks, as she very likely knows it already. The evidence that she knows it comes as well from her desire to meet me again after arriving in China and her anxiety in trying to know where I am when that moment comes.

In her arrogance and selfishness, she still thinks that she can control the events that life pushed forward for her to learn from, and that's why she cries so much. She is trapped inside her mind because her heart can't love.

This cycle shows itself at the beginning of a relationship she destroyed and at the end of it, when she moved to a new one that was never meant to work.

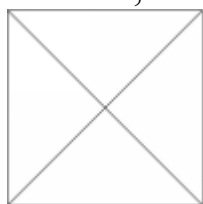
Those that can't use their heart but use only their mind keep continuously feeding from illusions, paranoia, anxiety and irrational fears. They are indeed very neurotic and mentally sick. And that's the proper way to look at such people as they are only victims of themselves, not necessarily fate.

What she can't see for the moment is that this journey out of the country isn't temporary but a physical representation of the end that she will soon face. And that end that she is so afraid of is very likely her own

death. Loneliness and depression deteriorate the mind and body at a much faster rhythm.

The 4 Triangles in a Square

The square that we apply to predict future alchemical events can also be divided in more elements, allowing us to predict many situations from other new perspectives, in this case, focused on the center of the intersection, the 5th or 9th element (if using eight triangles).



Again, following the previous example, we can consider the 5th element as a question: Are these two individuals going to end up together or not?

People always ask these type of questions when doing fortunetelling, and what they see is never necessarily a direct answer but a combination of answers leading to the conclusion. To be more precise, we can predict the future based on the elements interfering with it but only in that way.

One method to do this consists in looking at the four triangles leading to our answer. If we're talking about a relationship, we have to consider the elements that interfere with it: What does a relationship needs to work or to fix itself after a breakup? Some examples are...

trust;

love;

communication;

Interaction.

If one of the persons cheated, the trust is broken. So, we are now left with three elements. Love still remains because we both admitted it in our situation. And so, now we have to look at the other two elements to predict what will happen.

There is no interaction or communication because we are resentful at each other and living in different countries, and therefore, the 5th element will manifest a rupture.

This 5th element could manifest through the triangle of communication, trust or interaction. And I will now help the reader analyze them one by one:

First of all, if we both have difficulties to fall asleep and keep thinking about each other, this is a form of communication in process, although mental and illusory. And so, there are actually two triangles manifesting a positive manifestation.

The weak link happens in the interaction and the trust, because if I meet someone else, she will know that the trust is broken forever and there will be no more interaction between us. But, if she visits me or the opposite, the interaction between us will only be weakened by the triangle of trust, which means that healing is possible.

We would have to meet in the same space, face to face, for the interaction to lead us back to love. But will this happen? I can only predict it based on these elements, and I already did, by confirming my conclusions with other sources.

Interestingly, as I write these words, she has not decided yet if she will meet me again, as she fears her own humiliation, but I know already

that she will, even before she decided it. The three triangles are there already, on her side, pushing it forward.

If two people keep thinking about each other, still love each other, and one of them trusts the other, then, even if she is the one that cheated, she's also the one manifesting the activation of the new energy.

If we do meet again, it becomes obvious that the relationship can only be decided by the element of trust. This fourth element will lead to a 5th, because it will also interfere with the 3th, love. And this is why she now insists in blaming me for her cheating behavior, as she needs me to accept that I can trust her. As crazy as it seems, only if I trust her again can she feel safe about restarting the relationship we had.

It is also then with no surprise to know that relationships fail or persist based on trust. It's not that trust is an alchemical element of love, but that trust is, for most people, the most important thing.

Humans are the ones creating their own rules for love. Furthermore, that's why some people are ok with open relationships or cheating behaviors, as for them trust isn't necessary to make the relationship work.

Alchemical Conceptualizations and Divination

In the relationship that I mentioned, trust is definitely an important element, because both of us were always worried about being cheated by the other.

Even though a relationship can heal, if there is love, the interaction and positive communication between both people, trust either is built or eventually corrupts the other elements.

At this point, we have to clarify what is trust for us, and we do it by creating 3 elements for trust. If I mention how can I trust a woman, she will know immediately if she can be trustable or not. And if I look at my own elements from the perspective of the person I know, I can, again, predict what will happen, despite any of our independent wishes or wills. Here is how it occurs:

I trust a woman in a relationship with me if...

1. She doesn't travel alone to other countries;
2. She wants to spend her time with me;
3. She plans her future taking into consideration both of us.

I may be seen as arrogant by predicting everything about life before life decides what to do with people, before people, themselves, decide what they will do, but that's the secret to how I can predict things with years in advance and without any special technique apart from the one described in this book, which I use naturally by merely observing things as they are.

This said, I know exactly what can happen to destroy the relationship based on the previous vertices of the triangle of trust.

1. If she decides to travel alone, we are finished;
1. If she doesn't pick up the phone, we are finished;
2. If she plans her future selfishly, we are finished.

The price to pay at this point is so big that I know already what will happen. I have confirmed it with several fortunetellers and also with my own techniques when doing it. It is clear that she will decide to meet me again. It is also clear that we will have fights after meeting each other, and then, we will definitely end forever our connection.

I know this because her business demands traveling alone and constantly, and so, not to travel alone implies finishing her own business, and she will never do that. The price is too heavy.

This leads us to another important topic, related to karma. In other words, the main issue here isn't about what I need, what she needs, mutual respect, or even trust. The main point is that karma is always part of the alchemical transmutation of life. Whenever we do something bad to another person, we have to pay for it. And if we don't pay directly to that person, we will pay in another way. The universe never leaves us guiltless.

Now looking going back at our alchemical predictions, if she thinks that the price to pay for betrayal in love is too big for her, she will have to pay this price in another way. She will continue with her life, alone or with anyone else, but her business will collapse, one way or another. And then, she will be stuck in a relationship without her independence and without money.

The karmic price is paid when she abandons such relationship and faces her future alone. At that point, she might find someone to love, but only after she starts a new career, doing something else in life.

You can also apply the same previous exercise for anything else in life and even on your own. Your conscience and the 5th element are the same thing, reason why we always attract the things we project. And we project what we desire, even if our desire consists merely in the avoidance of a certain situation.

To be more precise, what is important to you is what is important for the 5th element. And if you want to understand a situation between you and another person, you merely have to question about what that person thinks if you don't know already, to then see how your own elements interact between each other. That's how you can always predict the future, even the one of others, and despite what they say or think about it.

This is actually a very interesting topic because whenever I predict the future of others, they always think I'm wrong, as if their will was more powerful than the laws of the universe. Humans behave like arrogant gods but they are always crushed like insignificant bugs.

Life only works well when you accept to be part of it, when you let yourself go in the sea of conscious emotions and thoughts, when you are aware of what you do and what you're creating, where you are going.

How We Solve Karma

There are only two ways to solve karma: Fast and slow. When I accepted that I had been very rude to my previous girlfriend, when I surrendered to my pain and the need to correct my behavior with others, when I decided to react with kindness every time my female friends send me angry messages, I met many wonderful and kind women in less than three weeks. I paid my price and I was set free. And so, I know that my next girlfriend will follow this flow of energy and will be a very kind person that I can easily love and likely marry with.

Good karma leads to good karma, even if in between we may have to deal with painful breakups, despair and the fear of loneliness. And that's exactly why hope is so important. Hope will help us see into the future and laugh at the past.

The hopeless is always blind by his own fears. And that's why when doing fortunetelling about this situation, every single person can see the same as me, that her new relationship, based on fears and arrogance, won't ever work.

Alchemically speaking, my ex-girlfriend could be that person but she wasn't ready to be it before, and now, after her big mistake, as the price is much higher, she definitely cannot pay this debt to the universe.

She knows this too, because she keeps saying: "I can't go back after what I did to you".

As with money, the universe also has its own flow of abundance and debt. If you demand too much, if you are too selfish and arrogant, the debt is higher. And the opposite is also true. I help the world so much that the universe brings me abundance.

The rules apply equally to money and love because everything is ruled by energy. And while many people work hard to pay their debts, many others choose to keep increasing them until they cannot pay them any longer in this lifetime.

There is no short way out in a situation like this, as my ex-girlfriend either sacrifices now everything for love, or she pursues her illusions and suffers for a few more years with her own deceptions. And I know that, unless she reads this book, she will end badly.

Fear is a sleeping dragon and running away from it feeds this dragon. One day, more powerful than before, this dragon awakes and burns everything within. It is at this moment that the pain becomes overwhelming. And yet, I'm talking about a pain that can't exist until there is a material and external manifestation forcing the inner dragon to awake. This is why breakups are important, even though more important to the one that doesn't understand what love is, as they do end up worse.

When we talk about alchemy, we are talking about the chemical transformation of the magnetic field and, obviously, it isn't independent of our own energy field, our vitality, emotions and state of mind. And so, people do behave according to what they experience, according to their own karma. The relation between inside and outside is perfectly accurate.

The reason why I can do fortunetelling without any tools, is precisely because of this immortal truth. Very often, and unconsciously, people reveal their own future. When my former girlfriend tells me that she needs a few more months to see if her new relationship will work and cries every time I tell her I won't pick up her calls anymore, she is already admitting that she'll end up alone after a few months. And why a few months? Because that's the time I need to detach emotionally from her. As soon as it happens, the new man, which won't make any more sense in her life, will vanish.

The reasons why one thing leads to another are never important but only that they do happen. A decision is always more important than any logic. Logic follows decisions and not the opposite.

The person that can't decide is trapped in a hurricane that keeps expanding, and that's karma. Metaphorically speaking, this person is like a princess being hold hostage by a dragon, her own and biggest fear.

The Purpose of a Karmic Debt

A person with a big karmic debt can't be happy and an unhappy person attracts more problems, despite any efforts to solve them. When we betray someone, we enter the emotional cycle of guilt, which has a certain vibration to it. And even though the alchemists have known this for many centuries, science has proven it as well.

The thing that a guilty person wants the most is to get rid of this feeling, and the easiest way to do it consist in making someone else assume responsibility for her own actions, reason why people that cheat insist in blaming a partner for their own behavior.

We know when that person is within this vibration because everything that she does consists in trying to make us feel guilty instead. After my breakup, for example, the focus of my ex-girlfriend was always based on making me feel guilty for what she did, because that's how she felt all the time about herself.

The reason why silence is such a powerful tool against the deceivers, is because this silence, by forcing a passive state of awareness, impels the other to activate his. It's for this reason that months later, the one that cheats tries to get a relationship back, as the feeling of guilt becomes even more powerful and difficult to deal with afterwards.

Guilt and fear are interconnected. A person does something evil, like stealing or cheating, because she fears, being alone, not being loved, being poor, etc. And so, whenever we do something that can make us feel guilty, we increase karma by default, as the fear we are escaping from feeds our inner demons, our dragons, our worse fears, trapping our soul in a cycle of pain and difficulties.

It is common sense that difficulties and pain stop us from working and being efficient in life. They exist because we can't move on without paying back what we did. And it's for this same reason that the best way to clean our karma consists precisely in accepting it and working towards cleaning it as fast as possible.

The interesting thing about this dynamic is that it works better when we notice how what we do to one person affects the others we meet. In my situation, this karma becomes visible when I'm forced to deal with

angry women, when I'm forced to politely reject sex or relationships with women that don't attract me. And I succeed in cleaning it when I am able to do it without allowing any resentment to form in them.

The obvious evidence comes only afterwards, when every single woman I meet shows herself extremely friendly and the complete opposite of my former girlfriend, which was and still is a person full of anger and resentment.

Basically, the best way to detach from a relationship that damages us, consists in recognizing our lessons and applying them as much and as often as possible.

On the other hand, in her situation she will have to face rejection, and this will happen when one day, suddenly, that new boyfriend decides to date someone else and abandon her. When she says: "I don't love him but I want to try this relationship to see if it works because I can get married" she's already admitting the obvious.

The only reason why people can't understand karma and alchemy is related to their own prejudices and personal ideas about what is right or wrong. Karma and alchemy don't obey to what humans want or think.

When I met my former girlfriend I committed this big mistake of thinking that, because she cries all the time, looks very innocent and talks about her past as if the men she met were evil by abandoning her, she was a victim. This because nobody is innocent. People can be stupid and blind regarding what they do but never innocent.

I'm so convinced today of my own words that I even accept them for myself. I pushed my ex-girlfriend away and the ones before her, because writing books was always my priority. I was selfishly putting all my love in my art. And that may seem noble, but karma doesn't care about noble actions either. What goes around comes around, and I lost women I loved because I wasn't loving them as they needed. It is simple to see it, even though it is not so simple to admit it. I can write seven books about the same topic, while not realizing that the writer is involved in his own stories as an active element as well. And yet, every time I say it, I liberate myself from the guilt and strike the sword of courage into my dragon's heart.

The Karmic Cycles

We can simplify the karmic cycles by talking about the difference between negative and positive vibrations. However, what few people understand, is that you can't fake reality. If you are guilty of something, you can't pretend not to be. That's insanity, and indeed, many people become insane when they can't face their own destructive actions.

Despite these facts, insanity is even a worse state than guilt, because insanity implies complete unawareness of self, while guilt has at least the conscience of self in it. The insane are within a vibration of apathy, a complete detachment from the outside world.

Guilt can't be erased and we can't escape from it with any strategy. Within the laws of this planet, it has to be paid. One way or another, that guilty soul must pay its karma feeding it.

This debt always applies, if not in this life, in the next. It is no surprise then, that those that feel too much guilt tend to be in a negative vibration that attracts more negative situations, forcing them to accept the consequences of their own actions. It's when they can't that suicidal thoughts emerge but also fatal diseases like tumors and cancer.

Suicide here is seen as an easy escape, a final rupture with life. And yet, once the individual is reborn the karma repeats.

It is as important what we do to others as it is what happens to us. Beyond the material world, there is not matter, space or time. Just energy! Therefore, it's as important to know that the woman in my story was abandoned at birth by her own parents and for the first twelve years of her childhood as it is to know that she abandoned someone she loved. The two things, from a spiritual perspective, are correlated, even though psychology will only look at it as a cause-effect situation attached to time.

It is as meaningful to forgive our past as it is to forgive ourselves within that timeline by changing what happens to us with what we do to others.

There is no future or past from a quantum perspective, and so, what we do now is as important as what was done to us and what we will do tomorrow.

The person creating a situation that leads to rejection and unable to see how she's causing her own future, is justifying her own past, in which she was rejected.

We can actually argue about the possibility of changing the past according to what we do in the present, because, theoretical speaking, this is realistic. It is as if we were inside a dream in which there is no timeline, only present, a present that keeps manifesting a different past and future according to this same present and in equal terms. That is, it's as realistic to change the future as it is to change the past, and it's also as realistic to predict the future as it is to remember the past.

The Relative Importance of the Past

I personally change my past by changing my present and future. So, for example, my parents never helped me when I needed but I keep helping others, writing books for humanity and, basically, accepting the karma that my parents offered me, transmuting it from negative to positive. And in doing that, I created a wonderful life, in which I don't need a job anymore. I can write when I feel like it and even not write and still earn more than I ever did in any job I had before. Even with five jobs at the same time, I never earned as much as I earn today, but never could I imagine that one day I would have a magnificent life by writing spiritual books. And this is what makes life so magical and beautiful. The adventure of existence is always greater than any movie, and much greater than our own assumptions and dreams.

In short, I made my pain become my happiness and that's how I fixed my karma. I learned from my own difficulties and loneliness, and decided to help others in the same situation until the day in which I have written enough books to move to something else.

I will know when that time comes, because life will bring me something better to give to the world, a better opportunity to make me even happier than now.

In the situation of my ex-girlfriend, her karma isn't loneliness, like mine, but love. She thinks she needs love, while what she needs is to give love. That's actually why she cheated, as she doesn't want to love, she can't, and that's why she's very sick.

She can't accept love from any man because her own karma can only be solved by giving love, not receiving it. And so, the problem isn't as much in giving love as it is in finding someone that receives it.

After me, I believe she will find a man she loves but doesn't want to love her back. At that point she will know what I felt and a new karmic cycle begins of her.

Karma doesn't punish but teaches by positioning us within different perspectives and until we understand what we must. That's why when people reborn they tend to end in different countries, in different

situations, to see the world from different eyes, according to their own lessons.

We don't only receive our karma but also the one of our family and country. Those that travel and can actually make a living abroad or change to any country they want, are unknowingly paying different cycles of karma.

This is so obvious to me that the people I encounter in different countries always seem familiar, in the sense that I know I have met them before, and that's why we identify so easily with each other. There are unfinished cycles between us.

After cleaning my karma with my own country, I saw it in countries where I had still karma to end, such as China, Spain, the USA, India, Switzerland and Thailand. And nonetheless, the people that remain close to me in any of these countries, somehow know it, as they feel a special connection that they don't see with anyone else, a link that is ending something despite the topic of our conversations.

Depending on the spiritual level of the individual, our subconscious can manifest more about the reasons behind the link we have with a person or even similar situations from other reincarnations that this karma awakens.

I have been in many countries and planets before, and for this reason my spirituality easily awakens the memories. For example, I once met a Korean woman in Spain that had just lost her mobile before finding me and needed help to find the way to a castle. Unknowingly, we met to pay karma, as I dreamt about ourselves in another life, in which we were both Europeans and lovers.

As for my last relationship, it made me remember another that I ended, in another planet, as that also emerged vividly in a dream. That is, this earthly woman made me end the karma I had with another female from another species.

Although dreams can be deceptive, when we are spiritually evolved enough and able to confront the truth as it is, they do emerge with more sharpness and evidences, leaving no room for doubts.

The Law of the Pentagram

Alchemy has been confused for many years as the art of transforming metals into gold and this metaphorical approach to the topic, although based on symbolism, from which gold represents the perfect soul, helps us in identifying the application and interaction of the energy behind the elements chosen.

Another interpretation has surely been the relation of these elements with nature. Here, we find the five elements as being fire, water, earth, air and spirit.

Spirit is conscience and the conscience of self is interrelated with the Devine conscience. We can only succeed when recognizing that, when acknowledging that our happiness and life purpose are one.

Once we gain awareness to what motivates us, what impels us into moving forward, there is a fire emerging from within that empowers our will to go many times beyond what we thought to be possible in the world and far beyond our own capabilities. This fire transforms the magnetic field and attracts to us all the necessary things to transform our reality. It's the fire that enlightens, purifies and changes the metal into gold.

The fire calls our spirit to action and manifests on Earth in the form of materializations. At this point, we reach the 3 basic elements that compose the law of attraction, spirit or desire, fire or will, and earth or action.

The other two elements, water and air, form the final stage of the transmutation, because fire cannot persist without air and air doesn't exist without the alchemical transmutation of water. We physically and spiritually need both the air and the water.

In our life, these two elements manifest as socialization and recognition. The air is love, freedom, and wind everything that inspires us and uplifts us. And we get it from the ideas and insights that inspire us to move forward in our existence.

It is very normal that people in love or in a fulfilling relationship may feel this air much more than others. Love is a powerful element that allows the fire to burn persistently. And among the best manifestations of

love, a family is surely the most common and one of the most well recognized.

It is relatively easy to start a project with desire, will and action, but few can persist in their loneliness, in activities without any love. Like the air, this love must come from outside. The inner fire cannot burn without the outer love. But loneliness depresses us and leads us into demotivation, the extinguishment of the fire, while companionship and uplifting relationships maintain that fire going.

Water, being part of one of the cycles of air, is correlated to emotions. It is through water that the will moves, and it is through water that we build or destroy relationships.

People in love can both empower or destroy their relationships. Their love burns the metals within, their beliefs, values and needs, leading to a pure being, but such purity isn't possible without the melting process. During this melting of metals, representative of our attachments, we develop fears and anxieties, and this is why love is a powerful fire that transforms the soul.

The worse thing that a person can do to love is betrayal, because the one that doesn't accept the fire but runs from it, that runs from the fear of loving someone, will never love anyone else. This fire will emerge at a later time as, not heat, but a burning desire that destroys the soul of the one possessing it.

The person that fears also needs, as the two things are related. And so, the need of the one that betrays feeds a fire with fear, leading it to an explosion, the extreme of a badly conducted chemical experience with our own body.

The Equilibrium in the Pentagon

It is said that behind a great man there is a great woman because what makes a man great is the power of will, his fire, which emerges from love, the water of a woman.

Modern society, however, has distorted so much the roles of each gender, that now women neglect their role as builders of humanity, lovers of men, and instead drive themselves by the need for recognition and admiration. In other words, it's as if we wished to invert the alchemical roles and make the water transmute into the fire.

This doesn't work and despite any type of will, and that's why marriages fail so much in modern days, that's why people suffer so much from heartbreak and that's also why, despite the billions living in our planet, loneliness has never been such an important topic of discussion as it is today.

In the personal example that I have shown earlier in the book, I referred to an ex-girlfriend that couldn't love me and changed me for another man. She was surprised when not finding any love in him and doesn't know why it happened, but the answer is quite obvious, as a man can only love through fire, not water. It is the role of a woman to use her emotions to promote such fire. Whenever a woman neglects this role, her relationships won't work.

We can then claim that it is possible to love anyone, but even though this is theoretically true, the elements do manifest in different levels, intensities and gradients. This is why we developed the sense of soulmate. A soulmate is someone that matches us perfectly.

Sometimes, this perfect match can be overwhelming and painful, and that's why my relationship with this woman didn't work. I have too much fire and a man with too much fire makes a woman that isn't emotionally stable anxious, irrational and nervous. That's why my girlfriends feel like they are on drugs when with me for the first months and then start losing control over their emotions and becoming mad. My vibrations aren't within normal ranges.

A man with too much fire needs a woman with too much love. And this is how we measure relationships from an alchemical viewpoint.

This doesn't mean that without love success isn't possible, but it's surely much more difficult to be successful when we are alone in our journey. In all the situations in which I have seen such thing happening, the person was an artist, feeding from the love of his fans and public concerts.

Interestingly, however, these are exactly the type of men that women are more attracted to, as they manifest confidence and charisma, both very attractive qualities.

Women are attracted to men with power and influence, because they know that this fire stimulates their femininity and challenges their role as a woman. In other words, men of fire awaken feminine desires, which come from water.

To prove my point, we only have to look at the opposite, as famous women don't necessarily stimulate desire in men. What awakens the male desire is femininity, the characteristics of the soul and body that can feed the fire. Men are as attracted to beautiful bodies and faces, as they are attracted to kindness, smiles and sympathy.

The worse thing a woman can do to a man is not to smile and not to appreciate him. And somehow, women are growing up with the idea that aggressive feminism will help them in becoming better persons, while this isn't true.

Men may feel lust for a woman that is sexually attractive but they always desire the one that awakens and maintains their fire within, not only with sex but love too.

Whenever a woman isn't attractive enough, she can compensate her attractiveness with sympathy and nurturing behaviors.

The Devine Law

The Devine law will persistently push humanity towards more fire and more water, to speed the alchemical process of changing and uplifting spirituality on Earth.

Within this law, whoever neglects it condemns himself to extinction. Humans can't evolve without these 5 elements: Spirit, Fire, Earth, Water



and Air.

To be more precise, we need: Conscience, Will, Action, Emotions and Love.

Following what was previously mentioned, these elements are correlated, as emotions reflect conscience, action reflects will, and love only manifests when the previous elements are well balanced.

What we feel reflects what we need and want, reorganizing our desires. Whenever a new life cycle begins, new desires emerge within us. And even though our present reflects desires from the past, the desires of the present are the reflection of the effects of the past desires.

This said, when we attract a job, a business idea or a lover that then disappoints us, it's as much the fault of others as it is ours, simply because we manifested that person or situation with past desires. And the experience will then lead us to emotions that force us to redefine such desires.

Whenever we reject behaviors and attitudes, we are rejecting the person that insists in manifesting them, and so, with every feeling of repulse, we push that person further away into a new reality in which they won't be part of ours anymore.

Within this process, conscience emerges as the guiding force. And along this way, depression is merely the manifestation of lack of responsibility over the emotions being manifested. A person that suffers isn't conscious of his own role in transforming his own life. And guilt is surely the most powerful emotion guiding conscience downwards.

Within this triangle, will and action will emerge as necessities. And so, it's only natural that people without responsibility feel more lost, not knowing what to do with their life and which choice to follow.

Mistakes, regrets and errors are always manifestations of an unbalance within the main triangle of personal power.

It becomes therefore obvious that the love for others, us, the world and our lover in a relationship, can only manifest after the previous four elements are balanced. In fact, it's much easier to attract a lover when this happens.

Let's consider this for a moment. What kind of person attracts more the opposite gender and becomes irresistible to a potential lover? We only have to look at the beginning of our relationships to know what we were exteriorizing to our previous lovers:

Conscience is reflected in how we communicate;

Will is reflected in how we interact;

Action is reflected in what we do;

Emotions are reflected in our happiness;

Love is the fifth element resulting from the previous four.

People tend to be so focused on their results, what others do and what they get, that they very rarely look at themselves, at what they are doing and emanating from within. Anger, arrogance, disrespect, rudeness and sadness are never attractive manifestations, especially when combined altogether. They are not even acceptable to ourselves, reason why we get depressed and feel demotivated when having them. Only the purification of spirit through the burning desire to survive can pull us upwards and towards a greater life.

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
