

Next on the agenda, you'll read of the International Mission Holders


Conference held at Flag where Mission Holders and their staff briefed and drilled on the latest expansion tools to take dissemination and delivery to a whole new level.

Ethnic Surveys

by L. Ron Hubbard

YOU ARE ALWAYS AT RISK OPERATING IN AN AREA WHERE YOU DO NOT KNOW THE ETHNIC VALUES. They don't even have a word for this in English which means exactly that.

It's the mores and customs. It's what do people believe. It's what is right and what is wrong. It is the solution of good conduct . . .

If you are going to control or govern or have influence upon an area, you have to make ethnic surveys. You have to find out what is most liked and what is next most liked and what is considered bad and what is considered totally evil. When you've got the lists of those things you know the control buttons of the society. Those are the buttons of control. They aren't just a "study."

You do an ethnic survey by going out and asking questions and by looking into books and backgrounds of religions. It takes a little while to get ethnic surveys, but you're at risk if you're operating in an area in which you do not know the ethnics of that area.

For example, what is "good conduct"? If you look over today who the heroes of stories are that are being written in the United States and England, you would be absolutely flabbergasted because they obviously are representing the level of good conduct. What is good conduct? What is being good? If you think you can answer this, that is your first mistake. What is good conduct today has very little to do with good conduct yesterday.


But an ethnic survey will resolve it, whereby you go out on a broad-scale basis and you sample enough of the population and you will find out what the new ethnic is and what their basic ethnics really are. Then after you have put together a code of performance for action, or the mock-up, you get *this* critically looked at and then you have it taped. That is putting in your "R." . . .

"IF YOU ARE GOING TO CONTROL OR GOVERN OR HAVE INFLUENCE UPON AN AREA, you have to make ethnic surveys . . . When you've got the lists of those things you know the control buttons of the society."

In doing an ethnic survey you are only interested in the majority. You are studying the human beings in the mass, not their personal prejudices. You can't just listen to *one* newspaper reporter and *one* prejudiced politician—it's too small a sampling. Ethnic samplings have got to be very broadly done.

Using this tech properly, you can put yourself in so strong locally with all the powers that be that if someone exterior tries to do something to you it just causes one awful

stink. Because you are putting truth up against a bunch of lies, and in the final analysis truth always wins.





We're Here to Clear Los Angeles

Standing at the threshold of The Bridge bringing Dianetics and Scientology technology to a diversity of ethnic and cultural communities, mission staff are opening the gates wide for spiritual freedom in Greater L.A.

There's hardly any other city on Earth that better suits an example of such ethnic diversity than Los Angeles. L.A. is just too big to be distilled into a clear, accurate description. The city of 3.5 million sprawls across 467 square miles of desert basin, mountain canyons and coastal beaches. Outside city limits, another 6 million people live in 80 incorporated cities within Los Angeles County. But that is the big picture. If we zoom in for a close-up, we discover a city immensely rich in human diversity and culture — people from 140 countries speaking 96 different languages who call Los Angeles home.

And for a round-the-city tour, let's take the fast-paced Los Feliz Mission for starters. What is it that makes this mission so special? Well, having been open for just over one year, Mission Holder and ED (Patrick and Jasmin Renne) and their crew have already placed 2nd in the International Mission Birthday Game. And with over 20 staff at an average age of 23, they've made it the "hip" thing to do to listen to the LRH Congresses as well as join the bandwagon on the "Say No to Drugs, Say Yes to Life" campaign the mission launched in their community. Located on trendy Hillhurst Avenue, the mission caters to young artists, photographers and youth of the local community. And they provide them with Standard Tech services, with a team of eight Golden Age of Tech trained auditors that move their public through basic Division 6 services and up the line to orgs. But it isn't just the Los Feliz Mission that caters to that new generation. Take a drive 4 miles southwest and you'll hear those same success stories right on famous Melrose Avenue with Mission Holder, Chris Baumgarden and his staff of the Melrose Mission — they're reaching out to the young "non-conforming" but creative types, who are now achieving their goals with Dianetics and Scientology.

Here's one of their stories: one young man who wanted to be an actor was in ruin about his career, depressed and looking for answers. He saw a psych and was about to be prescribed drugs as the solution. Luckily, a friend suggested he come into the mission instead. When he arrived he immediately signed up for Book One auditing and within the first few sessions, completely handled his ruin. He was so remarkably changed that he signed up for more services, completed Life Repair auditing, the Purification Rundown program and paid for his route to Clear. He's now currently moving on New Era Dianetics, is almost finished with the PTS/SP Course and his lifetime dream was fulfilled when he got a job as an actor with his show posted on the famous Sunset Boulevard.

While as for the Beverly Hills Mission, they not only service the business community and university students, they also have a large percentage of Persians in their geographic zone. And while Persians are very spiritual people, many have a language barrier the mission had to overcome. So the Mission Holder and her staff set up weekly lectures in their language (Farsi). These lectures were all based off of the chapters from *The Scientology Handbook* and resulted in over 40 public coming into the mission each week. The stories of life-changing wins are many. By way of example, one public took



the Volunteer Minister Course and changed forever. Previously, she had chronic body pains and was in apathy about handling it. She then started on the Purification Rundown with her husband and is now introducing friends and family to Scientology and getting them onto The Bridge.

And to hit the coast, all you need to do is take a ride up to the Buenaventura Mission. Not only do they service the huge business community, they also service the surfing community of Ventura. Take the life-changing wins of one of their public, a surf coach, who came into the mission with his life out of control. After receiving

his first services he not only 2Xed his business and trained other surfers who are now winning pro-level events, he's now moved to championship levels himself. Up and down the southern California coast you'll run into an array of those same successes from the Santa Monica Mission, all the way down to the South Coast Mission in Laguna Beach; and back up again to the Newport Beach and Redondo Beach Missions — each servicing their own unique ethnic communities. And while the Santa Monica Mission delivers lectures at the California Art Institute, the Newport Beach Mission staff have made incredible inroads into local high-schools wherein students taking mission services are also granted credits for their high-school education.

Life-changing wins are the order of the day such as the following story from one Newport Beach public: "I had been living in an out-ethics relationship for over two years, and had gotten into such a ruined condition that I had stopped eating for two weeks and felt like I had one foot in the grave.

"When I finally hit rock bottom I went to a friend for some advice who referred me to the Newport Beach Mission. That night I completed the personality test and was scheduled to come back two days later to go over the evaluation. I will never forget going over that graph. The results were so spot on that I KNEW that if I didn't do what the Mission Holder was advising me to do, that my life was over.

"I started with Book One auditing and Life Improvement courses and my life started turning back around. But, I needed more! I continued with two more Life Improvement courses and my self-worth continued to rise. I started to pay more attention to the chart on the wall that stated The Bridge to Total Freedom, and I wanted it. I felt like I was really ON The Bridge when I started the Purification Rundown. I had been involved with Scientology now for three months and couldn't get enough. With each service I completed, I was starting to get the full picture of the magnitude of Scientology and all it meant to reaching the goals I never knew I had. I knew I wanted more, I wanted to be Clear.

"The next step towards Clear was TR's & Objectives. Then, I continued onward and upward at the mission and then the org with the Student Hat, Method One Co-Audit, Pro-TR's, Upper Indocs, the Scientology Drug Rundown, Happiness Rundown, ARC Straightwire and right up through New Era Dianetics.

"With Scientology, my life has been limitless. I know who I am, and I like who I am. I have people that work for me that tell me, 'I wish I could be more like you.' And I have one of the best purposes in the world — to Keep Scientology Working. It is the only way out. Many thanks go to LRH whose voice is music to my ears when I listen to the LRH Congresses. I will forever be grateful."

And no matter the city in Greater L.A. — from West Valley, Simi Valley, Foothills or Woodland Hills to Brand Boulevard, Burbank, San Bernardino or Santa Clarita; and down south to Temecula and South Coast and back up again to Upland, Sherman Oaks or the L.A. Russia Mission to service the Russian-speaking community of Los Angeles — Southern California is now established with a veritable army of 22 missions and growing, delivering services to a multitude of ethnic cultures and communities.

And as for the last two missions that opened in Greater L.A., it was a grand day indeed starting with the opening of Sunland-Tujunga Mission where the likes of Captain Steven Zipperman (second in command of the Foothills Division of the Los Angeles Police Department), welcomed the new church and provided stats showing Sunland as having the lowest crime rate in L.A. This was followed with a welcoming given by the ED of the Pasadena Org and ended with a speech from the Mission Holder Linda Quay (OT VI and Golden Age of Tech Class VI), who gave her purpose in opening the mission; to provide real solutions to the day to day problems people face.

And on that same exact hour it was yet another grand occasion with the opening of the Huntington Park Mission — a mission established specifically to service the Spanish community of Los Angeles. It was a jam-packed event with over 500 people attending with no less than celebrity Scientologist Carina Ricco, who kicked off the event with an incredible performance lasting nearly an hour. Next on stage were the speakers starting with the PES of L.A. Org, followed by the Mission Holder Alberto Acosta, who spoke of his dream to help the Spanish people in his community with Scientology services — a dream which has now come true! Next and last was the Mayor who proudly welcomed the Church of Scientology to his city and praised the help they provide with their community programs. He ended off by quoting The Aims of Scientology at which point he then held up his own copy of *The Way to Happiness* and demanded everyone begin reading it as soon as possible.

And while this chronicle lays out like a patchwork of successes — it's a story not unlike hundreds of others stretching the globe — Scientology Missions working together, each in their own unique ethnic communities, creating a driving force at the entrance gates to bring whole metropolitan areas onto and up The Bridge. Strategies *for* Community Clearing

In a dazzling display of pioneer-spirited African dance, the pace was set for the annual International Mission Holders Conference at Flag. SMI Officer International, Ms. Claire Edwards, kicked off the opening speech to a packed auditorium.

EACH ATTENDEE WAS INTRODUCED COUNTRY BY COUNTRY and a new conference highest-ever was met with a collective total of over 30 nations represented.

Day one started right off with a briefing on the overall strategy of creating Ideal Orgs and a closer look at precisely where missions align to forward this strategy. It was a briefing that began with point #1 of The Ingredients of Expansion—Establishment. The Commanding Officer of SMI International, Mr. Richard Fear, conducted the Recruitment & Establishment Seminar composed of intense drilling of the key LRH datums necessary

for rapid mission expansion — a subject that couldn't be more important to any Mission Holder from the day he opens his doors. This was immediately followed with the release of the new Mission Recruitment Kit produced in 10 languages —

a package of new tools consisting of recruitment posters, standees, reference packs of LRH quotes used for recruit interviews, Recruitment & Establishment Drills booklets, a portfolio of forms for signing up new staff as well as a CD of each promotional item for re-printing.

Day two began with an overflowing Sunday Service in the Flag auditorium, followed by SMI Officer Int setting the tone for the day covering the subject of Division 6 public inflow. The most essential LRH references and datums on the subject were drilled, including a full briefing on the use of the Internet and how missions can easily post their own web sites and web logs as a means of driving in new public for service. This was followed with a briefing on the Field Staff Member program and the advantages missions have with an army of active FSMs driving public in for service. And to help missions accomplish just that, the curtains parted for the release of the new Mission FSM Kit — also in 10 languages. An all-inclusive arsenal for immediate public influx — including portfolios with key LRH references on FSMing, the Grade Chart, an introductory FSM letter, provisional and permanent appointment letters, FSM Activation Troubleshooter reference packs, selection slips, pocket-sized FSM reference cards, Free FSM Specialist Course voucher slips, Power FSM logbooks, FSM Guidebooks (with 22 service fliers covering mission services) and all on CD for easy re-printing. It was a release that brought the house down as it was exactly what missions needed and wanted to drive public in at new orders of magnitude.

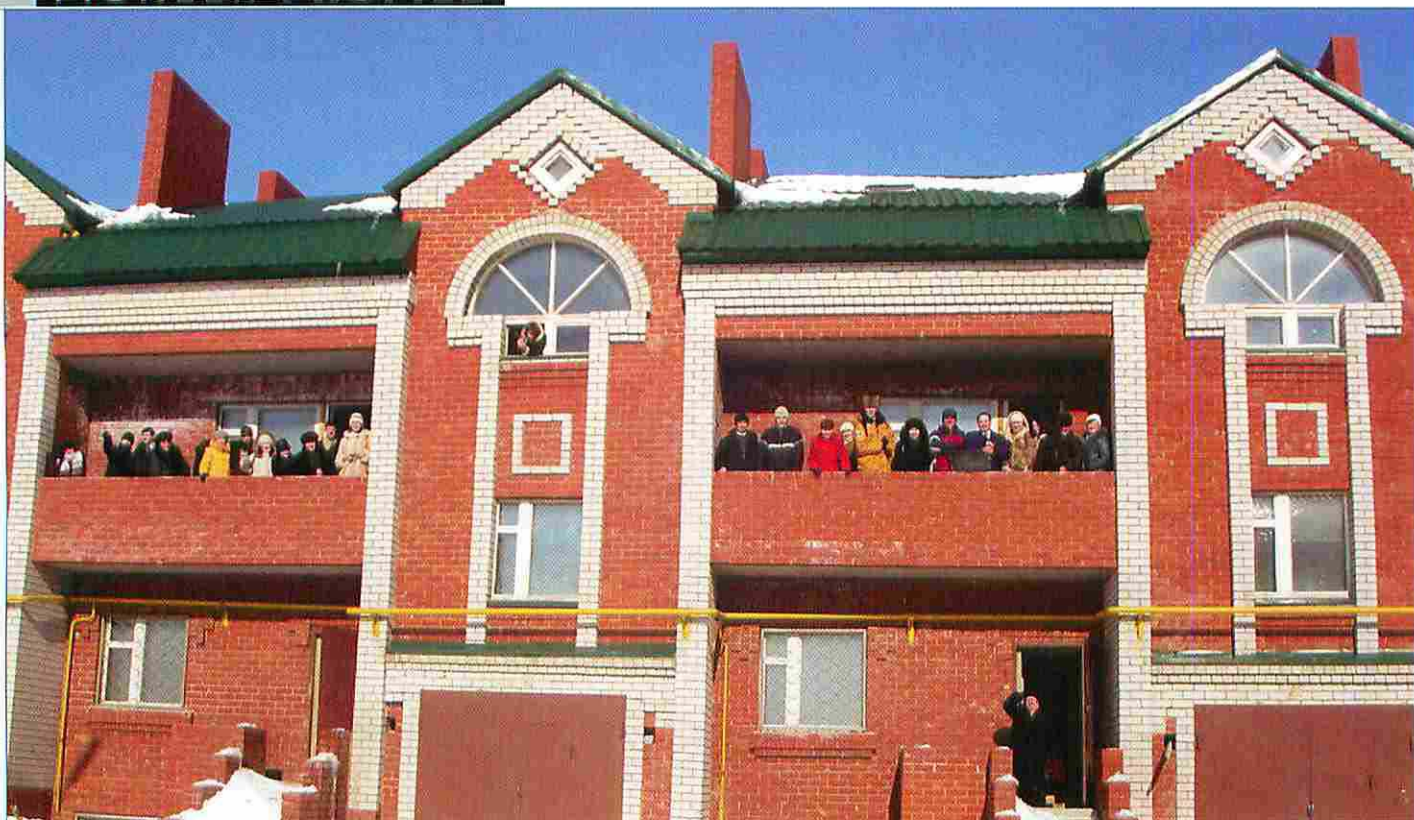

Nestled along the Kama River in central Russia, is the city of Naberezhnyye Chelny; and the location for our next story of the Church of Scientology Mission of Chelny. Mission Holder Igor Klipinister and his son Alexander, who is the Executive Director, have taken this mission from its

Operation: Salvage Cali

The story of one man and his team bettering an entire culture with Dianetics & Scientology

Known for its colorful atmosphere, salsa music & dance and beautiful natural views, the city of Cali in Colombia is the third largest city in the country, having experienced rapid economic and industrial growth in the 1950s. Yet, despite

its rich and prosperous heritage, a darker side began to lay its roots throughout the culture with the emergence of drugs, namely the notorious cocaine "cartel" based in Cali since the late 1980s. It became a nation-wide epidemic for which no

effective solutions were presented—not until Scientologists, armed with Dianetics and Scientology technology, began their fight for the salvation of an entire community. articles in the local newspapers and 16 radio shows right off the bat on *Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health*. With this immediate increase in promotion, hundreds were now walking in for their first service.

Meanwhile, Hernan upped the dissemination and delivery by continuing to hit the airwaves and TV stations while he personally delivered over 100 lectures on Dianetics. Concurrently, his staff were busy servicing a huge influx of public with over 1,400 hours of Book One auditing being delivered.

With Dianetics more popular than ever in Cali, Hernan next opened up comm lines to teachers, parents, VIPs, the Mayor of Cali and even top-
